THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Tuesday, January 17, St. Anthony (251-356) is generally considered to be the founder and father of organized Christian monasticism. Following his parents death and after ensuring his sister completed her education; he sold his possessions and gave the proceeds to the poor. He moved to the desert to live alone, and soon many sought him out. He miraculously healed and counseled those who came to him. He founded two monasteries and briefly left his seclusion in 311 to fight Arianism, and to comfort the victims of the persecutions of Maximinus. His example led many to take up the monastic life.

Saturday, January 21, St. Agnes. According to tradition, Agnes was a Christian girl of Rome, who decided to dedicate herself to the Lord and remain unmarried. When she refused to marry the governor's son, he accused her of being a Christian in the time of the Diocletian persecutions. In spite, she was sent to a house of prostitution then condemned to death by either fire or sword.

PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY JANUARY 18-25

Every year, between the Feast of the Confession of Saint Peter, and January 25 the Feast of the Conversion of Saint Paul, Christians around the world are invited to celebrate a week of prayer for the unity of all Christians, to reflect on scripture together, to participate in jointly-organized ecumenical services, and to share fellowship.

Since the founding of the World Council of Churches in 1948, many other Christian denominations around the world have come to celebrate the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. This year's theme is "*Reconciliation – The Love of Christ Compels Us,*" inspired by 2 Corinthians 5:14-20.

Christians around the world are invited to celebrate God's reconciling grace and to recognize the pain of the deep divisions which afflict the Church, and to become ambassadors of Christ's message of reconciliation.

THE SPRINGS OF SALVATION

In the Book of Isaiah, God puts the Israelites on their guard against the danger of quenching their thirst and appeasing their hunger at the wrong sources: "Why", he says, "do you spend your money for that which is not bread, and your labour for that which does not satisfy?" God wants to give us good things to drink and to eat, things that do us good; whereas at times we use our resources mistakenly, we use them for things that are useless, indeed, even harmful. Above all, God wants to give us himself and his Word. He knows that in distancing ourselves from him we will soon run into difficulty — like the Prodigal Son of the parable — and, especially, that we will lose our human dignity. And for this reason he assures us that he is infinite mercy, that his thoughts and ways are unlike ours — fortunately! — and that we can always return to him, to the Father's house. Thereafter he assures us that if we receive his Word it will bear good fruits in our life, like the rain that waters the earth.

What are "*the springs of salvation*"? They are the Word of God and the sacraments and we must nourish ourselves at these sources. We are like channels through which the life-giving sap of God's love must flow. If we cut ourselves off from his spring, we ourselves are the first to feel the negative effects and are no longer able to educate others. We must nourish ourselves at these sources, so as to be able to guide others in their development. We must give much, but in order to give we need to receive, otherwise we are drained, and dry up. For this reason we have committed ourselves by saying: We will "*draw water joyfully from the springs of salvation*".


It is very important to believe strongly in the presence and in the action of the Holy Spirit, to invoke him and to welcome him within you, through prayer and through the sacraments. When we pray we listen to God's inspiration in order to do our part well, which in any case is our duty and which we are bound to do. The sacraments, especially the Eucharist and Penance, enable us to carry out our educational action in union with Christ, in communion with him and continuously renewed by his forgiveness. Prayer and the sacraments obtain for us that light of truth thanks to which we are able to be at once tender and strong, gentle and firm, silent and communicative at the right time, admonishing and correcting in the right way.
