### THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

**Mon, Jan. 25, The Conversion of St. Paul** who tirelessly proclaimed and lived out of the message of the cross.

**Tuesday, Jan. 26, St. Timothy (d. 97?)** was a fellow apostle with Paul was with him at the founding of the Church in Corinth. He had a Greek father and a Jewish mother so was considered illegitimate by the Jews. It was his grandmother, Lois, who first became Christian. During the 15 years he worked with Paul, he became one of his most faithful and trusted friends who sent him on difficult often in the face of great disturbance in local churches which Paul had founded.

**St. Titus (d. 94?)** was a close friend and disciple of Paul as well as a fellow missionary. Though Titus was a Gentile (Greek born), Paul would not let him be forced to undergo circumcision at Jerusalem. When Paul was having trouble with the community at Corinth, Titus was the bearer of Paul's severe letter and was successful in smoothing things out. The Letter to Titus addresses him as the administrator of the Christian community on the island of Crete, charged with correcting abuses & appointing presbyter-bishops.

**Wedn., Jan 28 St Thomas Aquinas** (1225-1274 Patron of universities and students). Was one of the great teachers of the medieval Catholic Church. Born into a noble Naples family he was an exceptional student and joined the Franciscans in 1243 despite the severe opposition of his family. He taught in many European Universities and is the preeminent spokesman of the Catholic tradition of reason and of divine revelation.

**Fri., Jan 31, St. John Bosco** (1815-1888 Patron Saint of Editors and Children) had prophetic dreams throughout his life; several of which inspired his ministry to the service of abandoned young people. His free catechism classes after Sunday Mass soon grew into a full-fledged school where boys could receive an education, learn a trade, and love Jesus. His teaching methods were based on love rather than punishment.

### The Conversion of St. Paul

Paul's entire life can be explained in terms of one experience—his meeting with Jesus on the road to Damascus. In an instant, he saw that all the zeal of his dynamic personality was being wasted, like the strength of a boxer swinging wildly. Perhaps he had never seen Jesus, who was only a few years older. But he had acquired a zealot's hatred of all Jesus stood for, as he began to harass the Church: "...entering house after house and dragging out men and women, he handed them over for imprisonment" (Acts 8:3b). Now he himself was "entered," possessed, all his energy harnessed to one goal—being a slave of Christ in the ministry of reconciliation, an instrument to help others experience the one Savior.

One sentence determined his theology: "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting" (Acts 9:5b). Jesus was mysteriously identified with people—the loving group of people Saul had been running down like criminals. Jesus, he saw, was the mysterious fulfillment of all he had been blindly pursuing.

From then on, his only work was to "present everyone perfect in Christ. For this I labor and struggle, in accord with the exercise of his power working within me" (Colossians 1:28b-29). "For our gospel did not come to you in word alone, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and [with] much conviction" (1 Thessalonians 1:5a). Paul's life became a tireless proclaiming and living out of the message of the cross: Christians die baptismally to sin and are buried with Christ; they are dead to all that is sinful and unredeemed in the world. They are made into a new creation, already sharing Christ's victory and someday to rise from the dead like him. Through this risen Christ the Father pours out the Spirit on them, making them completely new.

So Paul's great message to the world was: You are saved entirely by God, not by anything you can do. Saving faith is the gift of total, free, personal and loving commitment to Christ, a commitment that then bears fruit in more "works" than the Law could ever contemplate. ~ From *AmericanCatholic.org* - Saint of the Day
