THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Friday, February 5 *St. Agatha, Martyr* is one of seven women, who along with the Blessed Virgin Mary, are commemorated by name in the Canon of the Mass. According to legend she was from a rich and noble family who dedicated herself to God and rejected the amorous advances of the low-born Roman prefect Quintianus. To dissuade her he sent her to a brothel then a prison and when she would not acquiesce had her tortured. She died in prison (ca. 251) while awaiting execution.

Saturday, February 6 *St. Paul Miki & Companions, Martyrs.* St. Paul was the son of a Japanese military leader who joined the Jesuits and became known for his eloquent preaching. He and 25 other Catholics (that included Jesuit and Franciscan religious) were crucified on a hill near Nagasaki in 1597 during the persecution of Christians under the Taiko, Toyotomi Hideyoshi, ruler of Japan, in the name of the emperor.

The Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy

Pope Francis is asking the faithful to reflect on the corporal and spiritual works of mercy during this Holy Year of Mercy. "It will be a way to reawaken our conscience, too often grown dull in the face of poverty. Let us rediscover these corporal works of mercy: to feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, clothe the naked, welcome the stranger, heal the sick, visit the imprisoned, and bury the dead. And let us not forget the spiritual works of mercy: to counsel the doubtful, instruct the ignorant, admonish sinners, comfort the afflicted, forgive offences, bear patiently those who do us ill, and pray for the living and the dead."

In great ways and in small ways, each day individuals, families and organizations help make the world a better place by coming to the aid of a neighbor. This always provides a mutual blessing – those served are blessed, and so are those who serve them. "The signs he works, especially in favor of sinners, the poor, the marginalized, the sick and the suffering, are all meant to teach mercy. Everything in him speaks of mercy". It is how his true children become known.

An important emphasis in the Year of Mercy will be the availability and the reception of the Sacrament of Penance in churches throughout the world. The Pope also encourages Catholics to make a pilgrimage during the year, whether to Rome or any other holy place: "May pilgrimage be an impetus to conversion where we will find the strength to embrace God's mercy and dedicate ourselves to being merciful with others as the Father has been with us."

LENTEN FASTING & ABSTINENCE

In preparation for the Solemn Feast of Easter, the faithful do penance through fasting, almsgiving, prayers, works of mercy and abstinence from meat. All Fridays are days of abstinence from meat, but in Canada, Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day. The law of abstinence binds those who are 14 years of age and up. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are mandatory days of fasting. On fast days Church discipline permits one to take a main and two lesser meatless meals which do not equal the main meal. The law of fasting binds those from 18 – 59 years of age.

World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life *February 2*

In the Archdiocese of Toronto we are blessed to have living and serving among us more than 900 religious men and women of 100 different religious congregations. This World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life is a wonderful opportunity for us to thank God for the gifts of these religious sisters, brothers and priests and to pray for them in their efforts to God's blessing upon them in their efforts to faithfully live the evangelical counsels of poverty, chastity and obedience. In closing the Jubilee Year for Consecrated Life, there will be a **special Mass next Sunday, February 31 at 3:00 p.m. at St. Paul's Basilica, Toronto** in celebration of the vocation and witness of these special men and women religious who are such vital and important part of the life and ministry of the Church in our Archdiocese. *All are welcome to attend.*
