THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Tuesday June 21, St. Cyril of Alexandria. An Egyptian bishop and theologian best known for his role in the Council of Ephesus, where the Church confirmed that Christ is both God and man in one person.

Wednesday June 28, St Irenaeus, emphasized the traditional elements in the Church, especially the episcopate, Scripture, and tradition. He recognized the canonical character of all four gospels and was the most important theologian of the second century.

Thursday June 29, Sts. Peter & Paul through their preaching, ministry and martyrdom are the founders of the See of Rome. Despite his weaknesses, **St. Peter** was chosen to shepherd God's flock. The Acts of the Apostles illustrates his role as head of the Church after the Resurrection and Ascension of Christ. Peter led the Apostles as the first Pope and ensured that the disciples kept the true faith. He spent his last years in Rome, leading the Church through persecution and eventually being martyred in the year 64 and was buried on Vatican hill. St. Peter's Basilica is built over his tomb. **St. Paul** was the Apostle of the Gentiles. His letters are included in the writings of the New Testament, and through them we learn much about his life and the faith of the early Church. After his miraculous conversion Paul spent the remainder of his life preaching the Gospel tirelessly to the Gentiles of the Mediterranean world. He was imprisoned and taken to Rome, where he was beheaded in the year 67. He is buried in Rome in the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls.


Friday June 30, First Martyrs of the Roman Church The holy men and women are also called the "Protomartyrs of Rome." They were accused of burning Rome by Nero, who burned Rome to cover his own crimes. Some martyrs were burned as living torches at evening banquets, some crucified, others were fed to wild animals. These martyrs died before Sts. Peter and Paul, and are called "disciples of the Apostles."

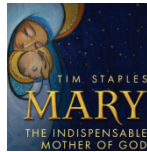
