#### BISHOP FULTON SHEEN - LIFE IS WORTH LIVING

"The Hebraic-Christian philosophy of pain believes that pain and suffering can be transcended. Suffering is transcended through love. Pain without love is suffering or hell. Suffering with love is sacrifice. Love does not have the power to kill pain or extinguish it, but it does have the power to diminish it... A mother sits up all night with a fever stricken child but it is not suffering to her; it is love and sacrifice. ... As a father sometimes gives bitter medicine to his child, so, too, the Heavenly Father gives it for some greater good. We know that somehow a cross fits into the plan and purpose of this sinful world; otherwise He would not have allowed His Divine Son to be crucified.

"If God in Heaven had not come down to this earth in the form of man and given us the supreme example of sacrifice, then it would be possible for fathers and mothers, men and women of countless ages, to do something greater, it would seem, then God Himself could do, namely, lay down their lives for a friend. Once He came, then never again could they say, "He does not know what it is like to suffer." He... showed us that without Good Friday, there would be no Easter Sunday. Never again can anyone say, "What have I done to deserve this?" He could ask from the cross, "What have I done to deserve this?" One can say, "I will accept this particular suffering in order to make reparation for my own Or we can also offer up our suffering for others...offered in union with the Cross. Pain, agony, disappointments, injustices – all these can be poured into a heavenly treasury from which the anemic, sinful, confused, ignorant souls may draw into the healing of their wings."






