THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Wednesday March 25. *The Feast of the Annunciation of the Lord* Celebrates the angel Gabriel's appearance to the Virgin Mary to announce to her the special mission God had chosen for her in being the mother of His only son.

When Mary signaled to Gabriel her acceptance of God's Will, Christ was conceived in her through the power of the Holy Spirit. While most of the Fathers of the Church say that Mary's fiat was essential to God's plan of salvation, God foresaw Mary's acceptance of His Will from all eternity.

We are continually reminded of the importance of this feast to our salvation in various devotional prayers. Two examples that highlight the importance of this feast are the joyous mysteries of the Rosary and the Angelus.

Intentions of the Holy Father, Pope Francis for March 2015

Universal: Scientists. That those involved in scientific research may serve the well-being of the whole human person.

Evangelization: Contribution of women. That the unique contribution of women to the life of the Church may be recognized always.



Lent is not about evening things out with God. Since our prayers and sacrifices add nothing to God's greatness or happiness, they are not primarily for His benefit, but rather for our own. Lent helps us recognize what we owe God, but even beyond that it is about preparing for the celebration of Christ's supreme act of charity in suffering His Passion and death for our salvation. The prayer and penances are a means to our growth in charity, which is achieved when obstacles between ourselves and God are removed.
