† Eduardo DeMelo**JESUS TOLD HIS DISCIPLES A PARABLE**

The parables are a development of a literary form which has its roots in Old Testament and rabbinic literature. Its purpose is to bring the listener to concede a point which he does not perceive as applicable to himself. In addition the parable whets the curiosity and attracts attention; the listener is trapped because of his desire to hear how the story comes out.

“Can a blind person guide a blind person? Will not both fall into a pit?” In Matthew these words are addressed to “scribes and Pharisees but Luke addresses not false teachers but the disciples; who are blind until they have their eyes opened by Jesus’. Once they have learned to apply the teaching, they will be able to teach others.

“Why do you notice the splinter in your brother’s eye, but do not perceive the wooden beam in your own?” This is an admonition to those who see their lapses as being minute in comparison to the gross failures of others. This obvious hyperbole (an exaggeration used as a figure of speech “this book weighs a ton”), gets the point across. **“How can you say to your brother, ‘Brother, let me remove that splinter in your eye,’ when you do not even notice the wooden beam in your own eye? You hypocrite!”** The word hypocrite originally meant actor. Here the meaning is a person deceived by their own condition. They are called to exercise self-criticism.

“A good tree does not bear rotten fruit, nor does a rotten tree bear good fruit.” Matthew addresses these words to false prophets but Luke gives a much more universal application. We need to look at the fruit the tree produces (deeds) and not at its foliage (words). There is no lack of people here on earth who, on being approached, turn out to be nothing but large, shiny, glossy leaves. Meanwhile, many souls are looking at us hoping to satisfy their hunger, which is a hunger for God. We must not forget that we have all the resources we need.

Living out the teaching of the sermon on the plain can come only from a heart that has been converted to our gracious God (read James3:1-18). ~ http://www.scboromeo.org/biblestu/c_ot_8.pdf

All Fridays are days of abstinence from meat, but in Canada, Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are mandatory days of fasting. On fast days Church discipline permits one to take a main and two lesser meatless meals which do not equal the main meal. The law of fasting binds those from 18 – 59 years of age.
