The Ascension

The Acts of the Apostles goes on to tell the story of how Jesus is present to the early Church and how Jesus works in the early Church, in and through the Holy Spirit. Next Sunday we will celebrate Pentecost, the fulfillment of this promise and the beginning of the Church: the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Church.

This has meaning for us here today as well, for just as the Jesus, through the Holy Spirit, was present to and guided the early Church, He does so today, to us gathered here. Each one of us was baptized and received that gift of the Holy Spirit, and most of us are confirmed, through which we received deeper the grace of the Holy Spirit to do the same thing as the first Apostles: to participate in the mission Jesus Christ, by bringing the salvation of Jesus to the entire world!

Not only is Jesus fully present to us here today because of His Ascension, but He continues to sanctify us and raise our humanity to one day share in the divine life in heaven. He also gives us the incredible gift of sharing in that same mission of evangelizing and sharing the salvation of Christ with all those we will encounter in our lives.
