### THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

<u>Wednesday May 18, St. John I</u> was elected Pope in 523 when the Arian heresy was strong in the West. The Arian King Theodoric sent him as his ambassador to the Eastern Emperor Justin in Constantinople. On John I's return, he was captured by the king, who was displeased at the outcome of the embassy, and cast him into prison where he died a few days later.

Saturday May 14, St. Bernardine of Siena was orphaned and raised by an aunt. When he was 20 there was a great plague, and he and his other young friends went to the hospital and served there for three months until the epidemic was over. At age 22 he left everything to enter a community of Franciscans. He converted many as hearts were so moved by his preaching that stores were closed and even the classes of the university were canceled in order to hear him. He rejected three Bishoprics, founded more than 200 monasteries.

Saturday May 21, St. Christopher Magallanes and his 24 companion martyrs lived under a very anti-Catholic government in Mexico determined to weaken the Catholic faith of its people. Churches, schools and seminaries were closed; foreign clergy were expelled. St. Christopher established a clandestine seminary at Totatiche, Jalisco and he and the other priests were forced to minister secretly to Catholics during the presidency of Plutarco Callese. All but three of the martyrs were diocesan priests who belonged to the Cristero movement, pledging their allegiance to Christ and to the Church that he established to spread the Good News in society—even if Mexico's leaders once made it a crime to receive Baptism or celebrate the Mass.

### RECEIVE THE HOLY SPIRIT

"As the Father has sent me, even so I send you... Receive the Holy Spirit". This is what Jesus says to us.

The word of God, especially tells us that the Spirit is at work in individuals and communities filled with himself; the Spirit makes them capable of receiving God, with the capacity for God, as the holy Church Fathers say. And what does the Holy Spirit do with this new capability which he gives us? He guides us into all the truth, he renews the face of the earth, and he gives us his fruits. He guides, he renews and he makes fruitful.

The world needs men and women who are not closed in on themselves, but filled with the Holy Spirit. Closing oneself off from the Holy Spirit means not only a lack of freedom; it is a sin. There are many ways one can close oneself off to the Holy Spirit: by selfishness for one's own gain; by rigid legalism – seen in the attitude of the doctors of the law to whom Jesus referred as "hypocrites"; by neglect of what Jesus taught; by living the Christian life not as service to others but in the pursuit of personal interests; and in so many other ways. However, the world needs the courage, hope, faith and perseverance of Christ's followers. The world needs the fruits, the gifts of the Holy Spirit, as Saint Paul lists them: "love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control" (Gal 5:22). The gift of the Holy Spirit has been bestowed upon the Church and upon each one of us, so that we may live lives of genuine faith and active charity, that we may sow the seeds of reconciliation and peace. Strengthened by the Spirit - who guides us into the truth, who renews us and the whole earth, and who gives us his fruits – strengthened in the Spirit and by these many gifts, may we be able to battle uncompromisingly against sin, to battle uncompromisingly against corruption, which continues to spread in the world day after day, by devoting ourselves with patient perseverance to the works of justice and peace. ~ from message of Pope Francis, Pentecost 2015


