## THE CELEBRATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY MOTHER OF THE CHURCH

Pope Francis decreed on February 11, 2018 – the 160<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the apparition of Mary at Lourdes, that Latin-rite Catholics around the world will mark the feast of “**The Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church**” on the Monday after Pentecost each year.

The Gospel reading for the feast, which technically is called a “memorial”, is John 19:25-31, which recounts how from the cross, Jesus entrusted Mary to his disciple as his mother and entrusted his disciple to Mary as her child.

The joyous veneration given to the Mother of God cannot ignore the figure of a woman (cf. Gal 4:4), the Virgin Mary, who is both the Mother of Christ and Mother of the Church.

The Mother standing beneath the cross (cf. Jn 19:25), accepted her Son’s testament of love and welcomed all people in the person of the beloved disciple as sons and daughters to be reborn unto life eternal. She thus became the tender Mother of the Church which Christ begot on the cross handing on the Spirit. Christ, in turn, in the beloved disciple, chose all disciples as ministers of his love towards his Mother, entrusting her to them so that they might welcome her with filial affection.

St Augustine says that Mary is the mother of the members of Christ, because with charity she cooperated in the rebirth of the faithful into the Church. St Leo the Great says that the birth of the Head is also the birth of the body, thus indicating that Mary is at once Mother of Christ, the Son of God, and mother of the members of his Mystical Body, which is the Church.

Honouring Mary as Mother of the Church on the day after Pentecost also highlights for Catholics that Mary was present with the disciples on Pentecost, praying with them as the Holy Spirit descended. Mary, “*from the awaiting of the Spirit at Pentecost, has never ceased to take motherly care of the pilgrim Church on earth*”.

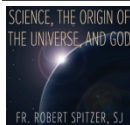

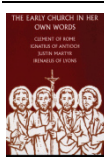

*"And on the day called Sunday, all who live in cities or in the country gather together to one place. And the memoirs of the Apostles or the writings of the Prophets are read, as long as time permits. Then, when the reader has ceased, the priest verbally instructs us and exhorts us to imitate these good things. Then we all rise together and pray. And, as we said before, when our prayer is ended, bread and wine and water are brought. Then, the priest in like manner offers prayers and thanksgivings, according to his ability. And the people assent, saying 'Amen.' Then, the Eucharist, is distributed to everyone, and everyone participates in that over which thanks has been given. And a portion of it is sent by the deacons to those who are absent."*
