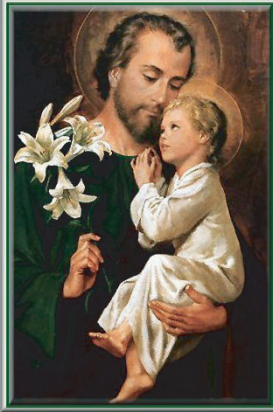

THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

On the Commemoration of the Faithful Departed

*(All Souls Day), we not only remember the dead, but we apply our efforts, through prayer, almsgiving, and the Mass, to their release from Purgatory. Praying for the dead is a Christian obligation and this custom dates back before Christ, as far as 2 Maccabees. During the entire month of November lists of names of those to be remembered are placed by the altar on which the sacrifice of the mass is offered. There are **two plenary indulgences attached to All Souls Day**, one for visiting a church and another for visiting a cemetery. The plenary indulgence for visiting a cemetery can also be obtained every day from November 1-8, and, as a partial indulgence, on any day of the year. While the actions are performed by the living, the **merits of the indulgences are applicable only to the souls in Purgatory.***

To acquire a plenary indulgence it is necessary the following three conditions be fulfilled several days before or after the visit:

- † Sacramental Confession
- † Eucharistic communion,
- † Prayer for the intention of the Holy Father.

Wednesday Nov 04, St. Charles Borromeo lived during the time of the Protestant Reformation, and had a hand in the reform of the whole Church during the final years of the Council of Trent. The religious and moral picture at the time was poor and he initiated regulations on the bishops and other clergy to give a good example and convert the people to the apostolic spirit. When the civil authorities fled at the height of the plague and famine of 1576, he stayed in the city, where he ministered to the sick and the dying, helping those in want.

The Lord God, beauty, goodness, truth, tenderness, the fullness of love -- all that awaits us, and all those who preceded us and died in the Lord are there, in heaven with God. Even the best of the saints were not saved by their good works, but by the blood of Christ. God is the one who saves; he is the one who carries us like father -- at the end of our lives -- to that heaven where our forebears are.


The feast day reading from the seventh chapter of the Book of Revelation described a multitude of people from every race and nation standing before God. They were dressed in white, the pope said, because they were "washed in the blood of the Lamb". We can enter into heaven only thanks to the blood of the lamb, the blood of Christ.

If today we are remembering these brothers and sisters of ours who lived before us and are now in heaven, they are there because they were washed in the blood of Christ. That is our hope, and this hope does not disappoint. If we live our lives with the Lord, he will never disappoint us.

We are children of God, and live in hope of one day seeing God as he is. On the feast of All Saints and before the Day of the Dead, it is important to think about hope.
