THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Monday Nov 10, St. Elizabeth of Hungary In her short life Elizabeth manifested great love for the poor and suffering that she has become the patroness of Catholic charities and of the Secular Franciscan Order. The daughter of the King of Hungary, Elizabeth chose a life of penance and asceticism when a life of leisure and luxury could easily have been hers. This choice endeared her in the hearts of the common people throughout Europe.

Friday Nov 21, The Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, celebrates the dedication of herself which Mary made to God from her very childhood under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit who filled her with grace at her Immaculate Conception. Mary, at the age of three, was brought by her parents to the Temple, in fulfillment of a vow, there to be educated. Tradition holds that all young Jewish girls were left in the care of the temple for a period of time, during which they were educated.

<u>Saturday Nov 22</u>, St Cecilia, Patroness of church music and musicians, is one of the most famous of the Roman martyrs. Depicted with an organ, St. Cecilia has inspired musical tributes by Purcell ("Hail, Bright Cecilia") and Handel ("Ode on St. Cecilia Day"). According to legend, she was not martyred easily. The attempt to suffocate her, then to behead her was unsuccessful and she bled to death for three days as she continued to preach. The story of Saint Cecilia is one of courage, evangelization, and love of God in the midst of persecution and strife.

from - DECLARATION ON EUTHANASIA

The rights and values pertaining to the human person occupy an important place among the questions discussed today. In this regard, the Second Vatican Ecumenical Council solemnly reaffirmed the lofty dignity of the human person, and in a special way his or her right to life. The Council therefore condemned crimes against life "such as any type of murder, genocide, abortion, euthanasia, or willful suicide". The Congregation now considers it opportune to set forth the Church's teaching on euthanasia. It is indeed true that, in this sphere of teaching, the recent Popes have explained the principles, and these retain their full force; but the progress of medical science in recent years has brought to the fore new aspects of the question of euthanasia, and these aspects call for further elucidation on the ethical level. In modern society, in which even the fundamental values of human life are often called into question, cultural change exercises an influence upon the way of looking at suffering and death; moreover, medicine has increased its capacity to cure and to prolong life in particular circumstances, which sometime give rise to moral problems. Thus people living in this situation experience no little anxiety about the meaning of advanced old age and death. They also begin to wonder whether they have the right to obtain for themselves or their fellowmen an "easy death," which would shorten suffering and which seems to them more in harmony with human dignity.

For all those who place their faith and hope in Christ, who, through His life, death and resurrection, has given a new meaning to existence and especially to the death of the Christian, as St. Paul says: "If we live, we live to the Lord, and if we die, we die to the Lord". It is hoped that this Declaration will meet with the approval of many people of good will, who, philosophical or ideological differences notwithstanding, have nevertheless a lively awareness of the rights of the human person.
