THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Tuesday Nov 10, St. Leo the Great, a dedicated Pope with a strong conviction of the importance of the Bishop of Rome and of the Church as the ongoing sign of Christ's presence in the world. He worked at length to control the heresies of Pelagianism and Manichaeism and with doctrinal controversy in the Eastern Church. When Attila with his Huns broke into Italy, Leo went out boldly to meet him and prevailed on him to turn back. Two years later, the city fell prey to the Vandals; Leo saved it from destruction. He died A. D. 461, having ruled the Church twenty years.

Wednesday Nov 11, St. Martin of Tours met a starving man begging alms at the city gates. Moved by deep compassion, he tore his cloak in two and gave half to the beggar. The next night, he had a dream in which he saw Jesus wearing the half of the cloak he'd given away surrounded by angels. Our Lord asked him to look at it and see if he recognized it. He did, of course, and realized that he must convert and devote his life to Christ. He then moved on and lived his life as a hermit. He became a disciple of Hilary of Poitiers and together they established a monastery. In 371, Martin was appointed by the will of the people as the Bishop of Tours.

Thursday Nov 12, St. Josaphat (1580-1623) was born in Lithuania and elected Catholic Archbishop of Polotsk (present Belarus). He was caught in a battle between Catholic and Orthodox and criticized and opposed by both: by the Orthodox for being Catholic and by the Latins for being Byzantine. He held firmly to Catholic unity against the Orthodox and just as firmly to Byzantine rights against the Latins, who saw unity only in Latin terms and would suppress Byzantine traditions in the name of Catholic unity. On Nov 12, 1623 he was murdered by an angry mob.

On the Jubilee of Mercy

On March 13, 2015, Pope Francis announced the celebration of an "extraordinary Holy Year". This "Jubilee of Mercy" will commence with the opening of the Holy Door in St. Peter's on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, 2015, and will conclude on November 20, 2016 with the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. At the start of the new year, the Holy Father had stated: "This is the time of mercy. It is important that the lay faithful live it and bring it into different social environments. Go forth!"

The Jubilee announcement had been made on the second anniversary of the election of Pope Francis, during his homily for the penitential liturgy with which the Holy Father opened the "24 Hours for the Lord". This initiative, proposed by the Pontifical Council for the Promotion of the New Evangelization, promotes throughout the world the opening of churches for an extended period of time for the purpose of inviting people to the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The theme for this year has been taken from the Letter of St. Paul to the Ephesians, "God rich in mercy".

The opening of this next Jubilee will take place on the fiftieth anniversary of the closing of the Second Vatican Council in 1965. This is of great significance, for it impels the Church to continue the work begun at Vatican II.

In the ancient Hebrew tradition, the Jubilee Year, which was celebrated every 50 years, was meant to restore equality among all of the children of Israel, offering new possibilities to families which had lost their property and even their personal freedom. In addition, the Jubilee Year was a reminder to the rich that a time would come when their Israelite slaves would once again become their equals and would be able to reclaim their rights. "Justice, according to the Law of Israel, consisted above all in the protection of the weak" (*St. John Paul II, Tertio millenio adveniente 13*).




