THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Monday November 21, The Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Today, this feast celebrates the recognition of Mary as a temple in whom God dwells. When she conceived the very Son of God she herself became, in a very special way, a holy temple. When she cherished the word of God in her heart, loved Christ so ardently, and faithfully kept his word, the Son and the Father came to her and made their home with her, in accordance with the promise of the Lord.

Tuesday November 22, St. Cecilia, according to legend, was a young Christian of high rank betrothed to a Roman named Valerian. Through her influence, Valerian was converted, and was martyred along with his brother. Since the time of the Renaissance she has usually been portrayed with a viola or a small organ.

Wednesday November 23, St. Clement of Rome; a Roman citizen of Jewish descent was the third successor of St. Peter. He reigned as pope during the last decade of the first century and is known as one of the Church’s five “Apostolic Fathers” (those who provided a direct link between the Apostles and later generations of Church Fathers).

Thursday November 24, St. Andrew Dung-Lac, was one of 117 people martyred in Vietnam between 1820 and 1862. He was imprisoned and repeatedly tortured during the persecutions of Minh-Meng, the emperor of Vietnam. 100,000 to 300,000 Catholics were killed or subjected to great hardship. Persistent persecution forced some 670,000 Catholics to abandon lands, homes and possessions and flee to the south.

CHRIST THE KING

The apostle Paul presents Christ to us as the first-born of all creation; the Lord of creation and the Lord of reconciliation.

This image enables to see that Jesus is the centre of creation; and so the attitude demanded of us as true believers is that of recognizing and accepting in our lives the centrality of Jesus Christ, in our thoughts, in our words and in our works. And so our thoughts will be Christian thoughts, thoughts of Christ. Our works will be Christian works, works of Christ; and our words will be Christian words, words of Christ. *But when this centre is lost, when it is replaced by something else, only harm can result for everything around us and for ourselves.*

Besides being the centre of creation and the centre of reconciliation, Christ is the centre of the people of God. He is on the altar, in our midst with us his people. We see this in the first reading which describes the time when the tribes of Israel came to look for David and anointed him king of Israel before the Lord (cf. 2 Sam 5:1-3). In searching for an ideal king, the people were seeking God himself: a God who would be close to them, who would accompany them on their journey, who would be a brother to them.

Christ, the descendant of King David, is really the “brother” around whom God’s people come together. It is he who cares for his people, for all of us, even at the price of his life. In him we are one people, united with him and sharing a single journey, a single destiny. Only in him do we receive our identity as a people.

Finally, Christ is the centre of the history of humanity and also the centre of the history of every individual. To him we can bring the joys and the hopes, the sorrows and troubles which are part of our lives. When Jesus is the centre, light shines even amid the darkest times of our lives; he gives us hope, as he does to the good thief in today’s Gospel. Whereas all the others treat Jesus with disdain – “If you are the Christ, the Messiah King, save yourself by coming down from the cross!” – the thief who went astray in his life but now repents, clings to the crucified Jesus and begs him: “Remember me, when you come into your kingdom” (Lk 23:42). Jesus promises him: “Today you will be with me in paradise” (v. 43), in his kingdom. Jesus speaks only a word of forgiveness, not of condemnation; whenever anyone finds the courage to ask for this forgiveness, the Lord does not let such a petition go unheard.

Jesus’ promise to the good thief gives us great hope: it tells us that God’s grace is always greater than the prayer which sought it. The Lord always grants more, he is so generous, he always gives more than what he has been asked: you ask him to remember you, and he brings you into his kingdom! Let us go forward together on this road. ~ from HOMILY OF POPE FRANCIS for Christ the King 2013
