

# SAINT OF THE WEEK St. John Paul II

John Paul II is recognized as helping to end Communist rule in his native Poland and eventually all of Europe. He significantly improved the Church's relations with Judaism, Islam, the Orthodox Church, and Anglicans. He was one of the most travelled leaders in history, visiting 129 nations. As part of his emphasis on the universal call to holiness, he beatified 1,340 and canonized 483 saints, more than the combined tally of the preceding five centuries.

- Many faith-based hospitals and treatment centres do not wish to participate in euthanasia/assisted suicide; no health care facility offers every procedure, so it is alarming to suggest we would start with one that will kill those who are sick
