

From The Parish Priest

SUNDAYS

This is the day that the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it (Psalm 118:24). For the Christian, every Sunday is a celebration of the Paschal Mystery which marks the re-birth of hope and helps us to put our own concerns into the broader context of God's designs for his world. Many of us can look back to an era when society at large treated Sunday as special, but we have to face the reality that a multi-cultural environment and changes in social mores mean that the onus is now on us as individuals to ensure that Sunday has a particular quality. The Catechism states: *"the Sunday Eucharist is the foundation and confirmation of all Christian practice"* and for the Catholic, there is an obligation laid on all of us to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days in fulfillment of the first and third of the Commandments. As the Psalmist implies, this obligation should be a source of joy in which, week by week, we celebrate the faith which we share. *"Participation in the communal celebration of the Sunday Eucharist is a testimony of belonging and of being faithful to Christ and to his Church"*.
