THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Monday, Sept. 14, Exaltation of the Holy Cross. *St. Helena, mother of the Roman Emperor Constantine built the Basilica of the Holy Sepulcher over what was believed to be the tomb of Jesus. During the excavation, workers found three crosses. Legend has it that the one on which Jesus died was identified when its touch healed a dying woman. The cross immediately became an object of veneration. To this day Catholic and Orthodox churches celebrate the Exaltation of the Holy Cross on the September anniversary of the basilica's dedication.*

Tuesday, Sept 14, Our Lady of Sorrows. *This devotion has its roots in Sacred Scripture and in Christian piety, which always associates the Blessed Mother with her suffering Son. Today's feast was introduced by the Servites in order to intensify devotion to Our Lady's Sorrows. In 1817 Pius VII — suffering grievously in exile but finally liberated by Mary's intercession — extended the feast to the universal Church.*

Wednesday, Sept 16, Saint Cornelius. *Elected Pope in 251 during the persecutions and threats of Emperor Decius, he brought an end to the schism brought on by his rival, the first anti-pope Novatian.*

Saint Cyprian (200-258). *Second in importance in the African church only to the great Saint Augustine and close friend of Pope Cornelius, who he supported against the anti-pope Novatian. He argued that unity is grounded in the authority of the bishop, and among the bishops, in the primacy of the See of Rome.*

Thursday, Sept. 17- Cardinal Robert Bellarmine (1542-1621). *A Jesuit and nephew of Pope Marcellus II, a learned and powerful defender of the Pope and one of the finest apologist for the faith that the Catholic Church ever produced. His greatest work concerned the main distinctions between Catholic and Protestant Churches that vindicated the spiritual and temporal principles and doctrines of the Pope.*

PROJECT HOPE – Refugee Resettlement Campaign

In recent days, shocking images and stories of refugees in peril have provided a wake-up call to the world. In response to this global humanitarian crisis, Cardinal Thomas Collins, Archbishop of Toronto, announced today the launch of “Project Hope,” a special emergency appeal to respond to the tragic situation. The 100-day campaign will have a target of \$3 million and a goal of settling 100 refugee families within the Greater Toronto Area as soon as possible. The effort will also require 100 volunteer committees to assist with settlement services. The archdiocese will prioritize refugees fleeing war and violence in areas of greatest need, including Syria and Iraq, regardless of religious affiliation.

On Sunday, Pope Francis spoke of the crisis: “As we witness the tragedy of tens of thousands of refugees that flee death in conflict and hunger and are on a journey of hope, the Gospel calls us to be close to the smallest and to those who have been abandoned.”
