THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Mon, Sept 29, St. Michael, St. Gabriel, St Raphael. Michael (Who is like God?) is the archangel who fights against Satan and all his evil angels, defending all the friends of God. He leads God's armies to final victory over the forces of evil. Gabriel (Strength of God) announced to Zachariah the forthcoming birth of John the Baptist, and to Mary, the birth of Jesus. His greeting to the Virgin, "Hail, full of grace," is one of the most familiar and frequent prayers of the Christian people. Raphael (Medicine of God) is the archangel who took care of Tobias through a series of adventures which lead to a threefold happy ending.

Tuesday Sept 30, St. Jerome. Was born in present day Croatia. Around age 12, due to his love of learning, his parents sent him to Rome to study both Greek and Latin where he was baptized at 18. He then studied with some of the great Scripture scholars of his time. Jerome felt that God was calling him to use his education to serve the Church and was ordained a priest. Pope Damasus called him to be the papal secretary and asked him to translate the Gospels from Greek into Latin, the language of the Church. This translation of the Old and New Testament is called the Vulgate.

Wed, Oct 1, St Thérèse of the Child Jesus. 1873- 1897) also known as 'the Little Flower' Thérèse Martin entered the convent at the age of 15 and died at age 24. She was canonized in 1925, and two years later she and St. Francis Xavier were declared co-patrons of the missions. "The little way" is her signature, meaning the simple love from the heart and acceptance in communion with God are the most fervent. Few saints of God are more popular than this young nun. Her autobiography, *The Story of a Soul*, is read and loved throughout the world.

Thursday Oct 2, The Holy Guardian Angels are angels assigned to guide and nurture each human soul. This is a development of Catholic doctrine and piety inferred from Jesus' words in Matthew "See that you do not despise one of these little ones, for I say to you that their angels in heaven always look upon the face of my heavenly Father." Their role is to represent individuals before God, to watch over them always, to aid their prayer and to present their souls to God at death.

Sat., St. Francis of Assisi (1181 -1226) Patron saint of animals and ecology. Francis is one of the most venerated religious figures in history. He lived the high-spirited life typical of a wealthy young man. While going off to war in 1204, he had a vision that directed him back to Assisi, where he lost his taste for his worldly life and soon took up a life of poverty. His life of simplicity and service to the poor and sick, as well as his love of beauty converted many people to the faith.



40 Days for Life is a community-based campaign that takes a determined, peaceful approach to show the consequences of abortion in our own neighborhoods, our own friends and families, by drawing attention to the evils of abortion through: prayer/fasting, constant vigil and community outreach. The mission: to turn hearts and minds from a culture of death to a culture of life. The campaign tracks Biblical history where God used 40-day periods to transform individuals, communities, the entire world. From Noah in the flood, to Moses on the mountain, to the disciples after Christ's resurrection, it is clear that God sees the transformative value of His people accepting and meeting a 40-day challenge.

When people think of the abortion issue, they think of confrontation, and we must change that. Instead of confrontation, seek conversation—and ultimately conversion. The pro-life message is one of hope and love. We are called to share that message and present it in a spirit of peace. As Christians, we turn to Christ as our model. The Gospel stories of the woman caught in adultery (Jn. 8) and the Samaritan woman at the well (Jn. 4) are just two examples of how Christ demonstrated love and compassion towards those he encountered. He did not back away from proclaiming the truth, but he was not harsh or hateful in presenting it. We are called to imitate Christ; to allow God to work through us to touch the hearts of those around us – to be the instruments through which He can spread His message – of love, not hate.

To do what is right and just is more acceptable to the LORD than sacrifice. -- Proverbs 21:3

Reflection: Living a life of integrity is costly. But at the end of the day, there is great satisfaction in the knowledge that we have done our best no matter what the cost. In the words of Dietrich Bonhoeffer, there are no cheap graces. [Day by Day with St. Joseph] "...Silence in the face of evil is evil itself. God will not hold us guiltless. Not to speak is to speak. Not to act is to act."

Prayer: St. Joseph help me to be a person of integrity no matter what the cost.
