ONE BLESSED LITURGICAL CELEBRATION

As Holy Week approaches, we turn our hearts and minds to the

celebration of the sacred Triduum. Over the course of three days, we will immerse ourselves as a community of believers in the most profound and glorious mysteries of our faith. The Triduum begins each year with the Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper; continues with the Good Friday celebration of the Passion of the Lord; and concludes with our joyful celebration of His Resurrection at the Easter Vigil. In the eyes of the Church, this is actually *one* single continuous liturgical celebration; a fact that can be noticed in the absence (on Holy Thursday and Good Friday) of the dismissal that customarily ends Mass. Consider making the time to celebrate the sacred Triduum *in its entirety*. This can make Easter that much more spiritually nourishing.
