Beginning this week, Holy Rosary Parish will adopt a few precautions to allay some individuals' fears related to the coronavirus. These include:

- Holy water will be available only from the dispenser in the Main Foyer. Please bring your own bottle to take holy water from this vessel.
- Holy Communion for the congregation will be offered only as Host (bread). The Precious Blood (wine) will not be offered.
- At the Sign of Peace, please continue to greet fellow parishioners with a smile, nod, i.e. a non-contact greeting.

#### DEVELOPMENT & PEACE The Mura: beset by buffaloes, plagued by potash



For several years now, the Mura people of Brazil's Amazonas state have sought to assert their claim to their ancestral lands. To their frustration however, it has been much easier for cattle herders and a potash mine to occupy and control those lands than it has been for them to have their rights respected. Development and Peace's partner, the Indigenous Missionary Council (CIMI), helps them advocate for, defend and publicize their cause more effectively.


#### KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS Men's Lent Madness Retreat Sat Mar 21, 9am to 3pm

#### MESSAGE FROM CARDINAL COLLINS ON BILL C-7 Nurture Life, Oppose Death on Demand! Contact Your Member of Parliament Today!

The federal government has tabled legislation to expand what they refer to as medical assistance in dying but is more accurately called euthanasia/assisted suicide. More than 13,000 Canadians have been euthanized since 2016. New legislation would make assisted death available to those without life-threatening illnesses including those with disabilities and those no longer capable of making decisions for themselves. Some Canadians may even be euthanized on the same day they make the request. We continue to pray and advocate for the vulnerable among us.
