RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

Over the past few months we have had parishioners inquiring if there is a specific manner in which to receive Holy Communion. As you can appreciate questions like this are good for all of us to stop and think about... For the next three weeks we will put in a few reminders as you come forward to receive Holy Communion.

Week Two: Reception of Holy Communion

According to the General Instruction of the Roman Missal: "In the Dioceses of Canada, Holy Communion is ordinarily to be received while standing. Just a gentle reminder that came from Monsignor Kroetsch as he explained to us the changes from the new Roman Missal that is: "we are encouraged not to kneel because kneeling may cause congestion and even tripping of people as they process up to the altar and are unaware that the person ahead may kneel". When standing before the minister to receive Holy Communion, the faithful should make a simple bow of the head. When receiving Holy Communion on the tongue you reverently join your hands; when receiving Holy Communion in the hand you reverently open your hands placing one beneath the other, and consume the host immediately upon receiving it."

The minister of communion raises the host slightly and shows it to each person coming forward to receive. The minister will say **The Body of Christ** and you would reply **Amen** (I believe), indicating by your response your belief that this small wafer of bread and the wine in the chalice are in reality the body and blood of Christ. As soon as the communicant receives the host, he/she consumes the whole of it. Finally as St. Augustine encouraged by your "Amen response" ...Be then a member of the Body of Christ that the Amen may be true.... Let your lives be a reflection of Christ to all you meet this week.
