BILL C-14

Bill C-14, the legislation on assisted-suicide and euthanasia, has had first reading in the House of Commons. **It is not too late** for people to speak out against the legislation and to keep proposed changes to Bill C-14 from going against the support of life. It is so important for Catholics to express their concerns on the sanctity of life and their belief in conscience rights for healthcare workers and institutions when they are faced with a patient's choice for assisted suicide (more on this issue can be found at: www.canadiansforconscience.ca/).

We know that original letters, phone calls or e-mails are the most powerful way to reach your elected officials. Please write to the Minister of Justice and cc a copy to the Minister of Health and your local Member of Parliament. Thousands of letters have already been sent to federal representatives and local Members of Parliament – they need to hear from your voice too. The more people speak out, the more they will understand how Canadians feel about this proposed law.

DISASTER IN FORT MCMURRAY

The people of Fort McMurray are living through an unbelievable disaster. Bishop Crosby is encouraging all Dioceses to issue an invitation to their people to send individual donations to the Canadian Red Cross or through

parish collections. All monies collected will assist the Catholic parishes and parishioners in Fort McMurray, as well as the Fort McMurray Ministerial Association, in their work and ministry for those struggling with the losses and damage of the wildfires.
