To date I have had triple by-pass surgery, three hip replacement operations and one knee joint replacement. Those of you who have had major surgery know that before each surgery you have to sign a waiver stating that you are aware of the possible complications and side-effects that could follow the procedure --- one of which is death. For me, it was a good opportunity for prayerful reflection and examination; either I believed all the things I preached or I didn't. And if death is a possibility, do I really believe that there is something more, something beyond all this? Truthfully, in the depths of my being, I believe there is; my answer was YES!

This weekend we are invited to bask and bath in the central mystery of our faith, the death and resurrection of Jesus. Either we believe it or not. Everything about our faith rises and falls on the acceptance of this crucial event.

Even though the ultimate finish point has to be a yes or no, we all realize that getting there is no easy trip.

When I was a chaplain at the university, the students and I went on an annual conference somewhere in the province. Many times we were in the van in the middle of a snow storm. They would ask me what I do when the driving conditions get bad. Jokingly, I almost always told them the same thing, "Don't worry. When it gets too bad, I just close my eyes!" I know that closing one's eyes to the storms on the road --- or the storms in life --- is not going to change anything but the truth is, there come times when we encounter situations that are out of our control, beyond our

ability to manipulate or avoid. Like sailors at sea in the midst of a storm, we can do little except batten down the hatches and ride it out with confidence that the storm will not last forever and that eventually we will arrive at a safe and calm port.

With the disciples we walk the way of the cross this weekend. We eat with Jesus at the table and he leaves us bread and wine that have been transformed into his abiding presence but we scarcely understand what he is talking about. We sit stunned outside in the courtyard as our mentor, friend and leader is tried, convicted and lead away to be crucified on the hill called Golgotha. The darkness and confusion deepens as his lifeless body is taken down from the cross and laid in a tomb. And then we sit in silence, at a loss for words, outside the huge stone rolled across the tomb entrance. To believe or not to believe? That is the question.

On the third day, rumors of resurrection rumble through the community. Is it true? Is he risen? And so here we are some 2000 years later and we have to face the same questions of faith that challenged our ancestors so long ago. Ultimately our life too brings us to sit outside the closed tomb. Do we believe that this is the end or not? Believing does not mean we will have a clear idea of what's going to happen; it simply means that we refuse to say that this is the end. Believing in the resurrection invites to a new life, a new beginning, a transformation, a world for which we can neither ask for nor imagine. It is too good to be true but it's true!

May the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead bring you hope, life, peace and wholeness as you continue your journey home to the invitation to your own resurrection. Christ is alive! Alleluia!
