#### THE EASTER / GOSPEL MESSAGE

- 1.) God made us for a loving relationship with Him, giving us free will so that we could freely choose to love Him.
- 2.) Abuse of free will, sin, broke that relationship, creating a humanly unbridgeable gap between us and God for all eternity.
- 3.) Through His passion, death on the Cross and resurrection, Jesus offers us a way to restore that relationship.
- 4.) Restoration is ours if we individually and freely accept Jesus as our Lord and Saviour. Such a decision normally implies Baptism, ongoing discipleship, participation in the worshipping community and bringing the Good News to others, all in the power of God's Spirit.


Have you received Jesus as your personal Lord and Saviour? Are you living a life empowered by God's Holy Spirit? If not, there is no time like the present to set matters straight.

## PRAYING A SIMPLE HEARTFELT PRAYER LIKE THIS ONE IS A GREAT START:

I renounce Satan and all wrongdoing. I believe that Jesus is the Son of God, that He died to free me from my sins, and that He rose to bring me new life. Lord Jesus Christ, I want to belong to you from now on. I want to be free fom the dominion of darkness and the rule of Satan, and I want to enter into Your Kingdom and be part of Your people. I will turn away from all wrongdoing. I ask You to forgive all the sins that I have committed. I offer my life to You, and I promise to obey You as my Lord. I ask You to baptize me in Your Holy Spirit. Amen.

If you sincerely prayed a prayer such as this one, know that God has heard the cry of your heart and is acting in your life.

## PLENARY INDULGENCE FOR DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

To ensure that the faithful would observe this day with intense devotion, the Holy Father established a plenary indulgence so that the faithful might receive in great abundance the gift of consolation of the Holy Spirit. In this way they can foster a growing love for God and for neighbour, and after they have obtained God's pardon, they, in turn, might show a prompt pardon to their brothers and sisters.

The plenary indulgence is granted under the usual conditions (confession, Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father), who, on Divine Mercy Sunday, in any church or chapel, take part in prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or, who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the *Our Father* and the *Creed*, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. *Merciful Jesus, I trust in You!*)
