JESUS IS RISEN FROM THE DEAD ... HE IS RISEN INDEED! AND WE, TOO, ARE CALLED TO RISE FROM THE DEAD.

How do you feel about being called a saint? That was the question Ralph Martin asked of us at the diocesan mission last week. Martin acknowledged that most of us wouldn't be comfortable with that. Yet, the truth is that the average, normal, everyday Christians in the New Testament were called saints. This was not because they were ready to be canonized, but because Jesus had taken hold of them. They had become Baptized, the Holy Spirit was dwelling in them. In 1 Cor 6 we read: "Don't you know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit?" Maybe you still fall and



maybe you still get angry or do this, that or the other thing, but something radical has happened to you because of the Sacrament of Baptism; God Himself is dwelling in you! He has taken hold of us and we belong to Him.

Pope Saint John Paul II reminded us that one of the major words that the Holy Spirit is saying to the Church today is the universal call to holiness. The holiness isn't just for a few special people, it isn't just for some Italian mystics who have the stigmata, it's for every single person who has said yes to Jesus and became part of His people, the Church. We're called to love the Father as He loves the Father and to experience the Father's love as He experiences the Father's love. And to love other people as He loves them. He wants our heart and His heart to become one. He wants our mind and His mind to become one. He wants our spirit and His Spirit to become one. That's what growing in holiness is all about.

Sometimes we may feel that holiness is a burden that God is placing on us, but it isn't. It's a blessing that He's trying to give us. It's a freedom that He's trying to give us. It's a love that He's trying to give us. Holiness is a call to be whom God created us to be, saying yes to our deepest identity. The only reason that God created us is to be one with Him! Sounds radical, doesn't it!

Just say yes to the Word of God. Just say yes to the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. Just say yes to grace. Everyday get up and say: "Lord I want to say yes to Your will. I want to say yes to what You've called me to. I want to live my life in a way that's pleasing to You, and as much as possible, lived in love."

Brothers and sisters, Jesus gave His yes at the Cross of Calvary on that first Good Friday and rose from the dead on Easter Sunday that we, too, by the power of His Spirit, can experience abundant life both now and in eternity. Let's give Him our yes and keep on giving Him our yes until that great and glorious day when we see Him face to face and live with Him in heaven for all eternity.




