PLEASE JOIN US FOR A CONCERT WITH A CAUSE

This **Friday December 12th**, our parish will host a 12-member contemporary Christian music group from the Montreal area, Aramico. The group's goal is to spread the love of God through music, while the concert has a two-fold purpose - to provide an opportunity to enjoy a time of praise and worship and to raise funds to launch a new parish ministry to the disenfranchised anawim among us, notably some of our neighbours on Cornwall Island where our parish has begun to offer ministry rather than relying on the Diocese of Valleyfield QC to address spiritual needs of Ontarians.

Scripture is replete with references to the anawim. The lowly anawim include both those who are humbled by circumstance beyond their control, as well as those who willingly humble themselves in order to bring glory to God and in order to advance His Kingdom here on Earth. All are called to recognize God's presence among the anawim and to be at one with them.

At the core of the Aramico group are two couples with a high priority on building strong families, and evangelizing using powerful Christian music to uplift those who are weary. They've twice ministered at weekend Masses here at St. Columban. Lead singer Michelle Lao is a celebrated vocalist. Lao was the Canadian GPSI 2013 Grand Prize Winner and 1st Runner-up in the 2014 DZMM World Caravan Global Pinoy Singing Idol finals in the Filipines, representing Canada. Various members of the group are well-known musicians in the Montreal area. Those who've grooved to the music of the Just Us Band will have an idea of the calibre of their musical ability.

Aramico's lead singer, Michelle Lao, is the First Runner Up in the 2014 DZMM World Caravan Global Pinoy Singing Idol finals.



The repertoire for the evening includes Paul Baloche's 'Open the Eyes of My Heart', Tim Hughes' 'Here I am to Worship', as well as a number of Hillsong pieces such as 'The Power of Your Love' and 'Shout to the Lord.' Hillsong music is definitely at the core of the group's most loved songs. The music style, which is popular among people of varying ages is engaging and at times intimate.

Fr. Jerome has been persuaded to bring his guitar and treat attendees with a short medley as well. Fr. J. first encountered Aramico core group members eight years ago when he served at St. Patrick of the Island Parish in Pincourt.

The concert starts at 7 p.m.; \$15 tickets are available after Masses this weekend and at the parish office. Students of our three Catholic High Schools are offered a special rate of \$10 per person if obtained through the school; the same is true for our diocesan youth ministry via Sr. Francine.
