It matters not whether Christ calls us to serve on a faraway mission field or to a far humbler task—ushering, singing in the choir, setting up coffee, visiting a shut-in, feeding a hungry person, or giving our last dollar. In Christ's hands, the modest task becomes a vehicle for epiphany—revelation—discovery and greater faith.
