A CALL TO CONVERSION

STEPS TO DISCIPLESHIP

If we say that we're too busy to pray, we're too busy. Nothing is more important in life than having a relationship with our heavenly Father that will lead us to eternal life. Persevere and before we know it, God will be changing things deep within us and we'll begin to see how God is working in our lives.

Will you recognize the One Who is leading you on this journey?
