DIVINE REVELATION

God Himself has established a standard for speaking to and guiding His people through the ministry of the Church.

Three Dimensions

- 1.) Sacred Scripture
- 2.) Sacred Tradition
- 3.) The Magisterium which safeguards the first two



Key Concepts:

- 1.) God lovingly chose to reveal Himself and has given Himself to man.
- 2.) Jesus Christ is the fullness of all revelation.
- 3.) Tradition & Scripture:
 The Transmission of Divine Revelation
- 4.) The Magisterium of the Church: The Interpreter of Divine Revelation
- 5.) To know God's Revelation for us, we need Scripture, Tradition and the Magisterium. One cannot stand without the other. Refer to the three-legged stool above.

"The word of God is that word preached by the Apostles in obedience to the command of the Risen Jesus: 'Go into all the world and preach the Gospel to the whole creation' (Mk. 16:15). The word of God is thus handed on in the Church's living Tradition. Finally, the word of God, attested and divinely inspired, is sacred Scripture, the Old and New Testaments. All this helps us to see that, while in the Church we greatly venerate the sacred Scriptures, the Christian faith is not a 'religion of the book': Christianity is the 'religion of the word of God,' not of 'a written and mute word, but of the incarnate and living Word' (qtd. from St. Bernard of Clairvaux). Consequently the Scripture is to be proclaimed, heard, read, received and experienced as the word of God, in the stream of the apostolic Tradition from which it is inseparable" (Verbum Domini, 7).

2016 CHRISM MASS

There is lots new about this year's Chrism Mass, including a new celebrant, a new day and a new church.

Please join Archbishop Terrence Prendergast and the priests in the diocese, for the annual blessing of the oils at the Chrism Mass. These oils will be distributed to the parishes of the Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall for use during the coming year. At this special Mass all our priests are given the opportunity to renew their priestly promises during the Liturgy. General seating is available to those who would like to attend.

ABOUT THE CHRISM MASS

At the Chrism Mass -- which is usually the largest annual gathering of clergy and faithful most dioceses have -- the priests renew the promises they made at their ordination.

The Mass takes its name from the most eminent of the three holy oils which the bishop commissions for his local churches' use over the following year.

While the Oil of the Sick, used for those who seek the anointing, and the Oil of the Catechumens, which is imposed on those preparing for baptism, are blessed, the Sacred Chrism is consecrated. All the priests present participate in the latter moment by extending their hands toward the vessel containing it as the bishop says the prayer of consecration.

The Chrism is used at the ordination of priests and bishops, baptisms, confirmations, the consecration of altars and the blessing of churches, where the walls are smeared with it in the shape of the sign of the cross.

As part of the consecration of the Chrism, balsam is poured into the oil, which gives it a sweet smell intended to remind those who encounter it of the "odor of sanctity" to which those people and things who are marked with it, and by extension all of us, are called to strive for.

The Chrism Mass also provides an opportunity to the faithful of the diocese to show support for their priests.
