When the message of salvation falls on deaf ears, do not become irate and make a scene that will harden the hearts of those who refuse to listen. Shake the dust off your feet and leave the path open to try again later.



I would like to bring to your attention that as of May 31, 2018 our collection is down \$4,155.00 from the previous year of May 31, 2017. To meet our projected budget for the year Jan. 2018 to Dec. 31, 2018, we must collect \$4,000.00 each week. The Finance Council asks each parishioner to consider increasing their weekly contribution so that we can balance the budget. Thank you.
