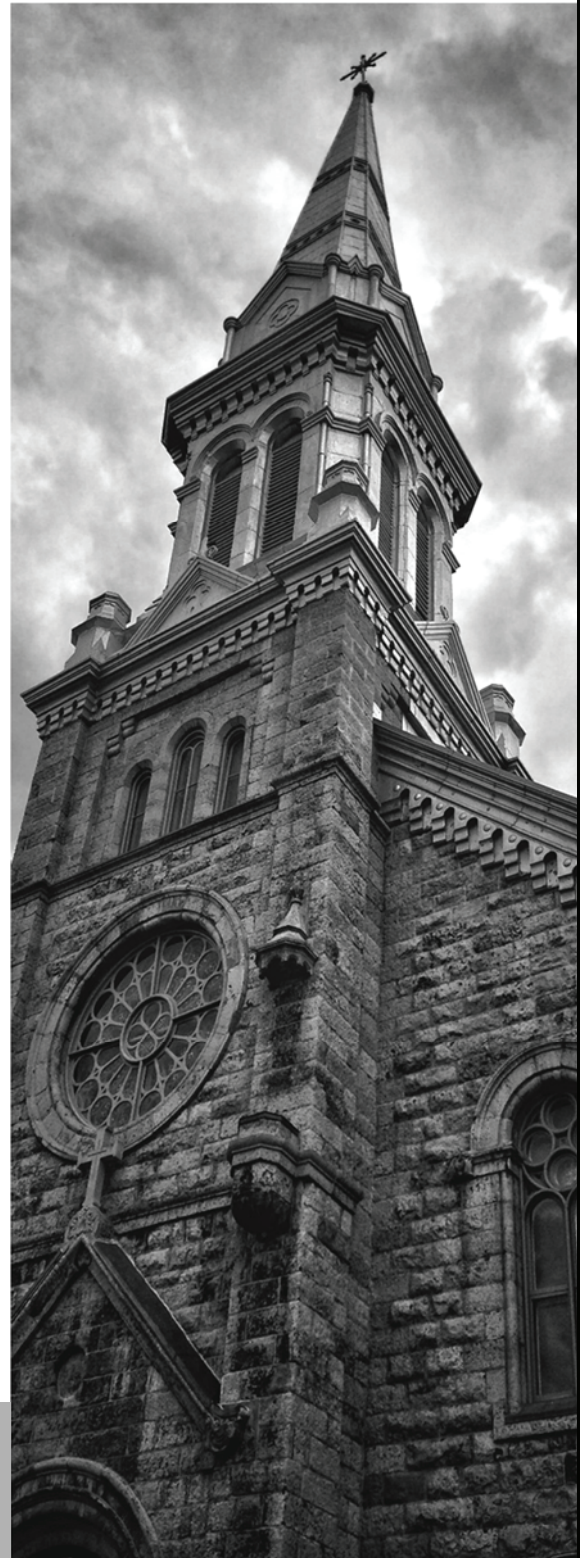

THE FATIMA FILM SERIES

The Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall in partnership with the Port Theatre presents this series to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the Apparitions at Fatima.

On Thursday, July 13th at 1:30 pm we continue our Fatima Film Series with not one but two documentaries. The first is the 60-minute documentary narrated by Ricardo Montalban entitled ***Fatima: Altar of the World***, which provides a true global perspective to Mary's dramatic appearances in 1917. Following this documentary we will screen ***Liberating a Continent: John Paul II and the Fall of Communism***, which poignantly captures the intricate role played by St. John Paul II in the collapse of communism and the liberation of Central and Eastern Europe. When Saint John Paul II was shot on May 13, 1981, he attributed his survival to Our Lady of Fatima. One year later he went to Fatima to offer the Virgin one of the bullets. This bullet was placed in the crown of the statue of Our Lady in the Chapel of the apparitions. Both documentaries will be screened at The Port Theatre. Admission is FREE, however a donation would be appreciated.
