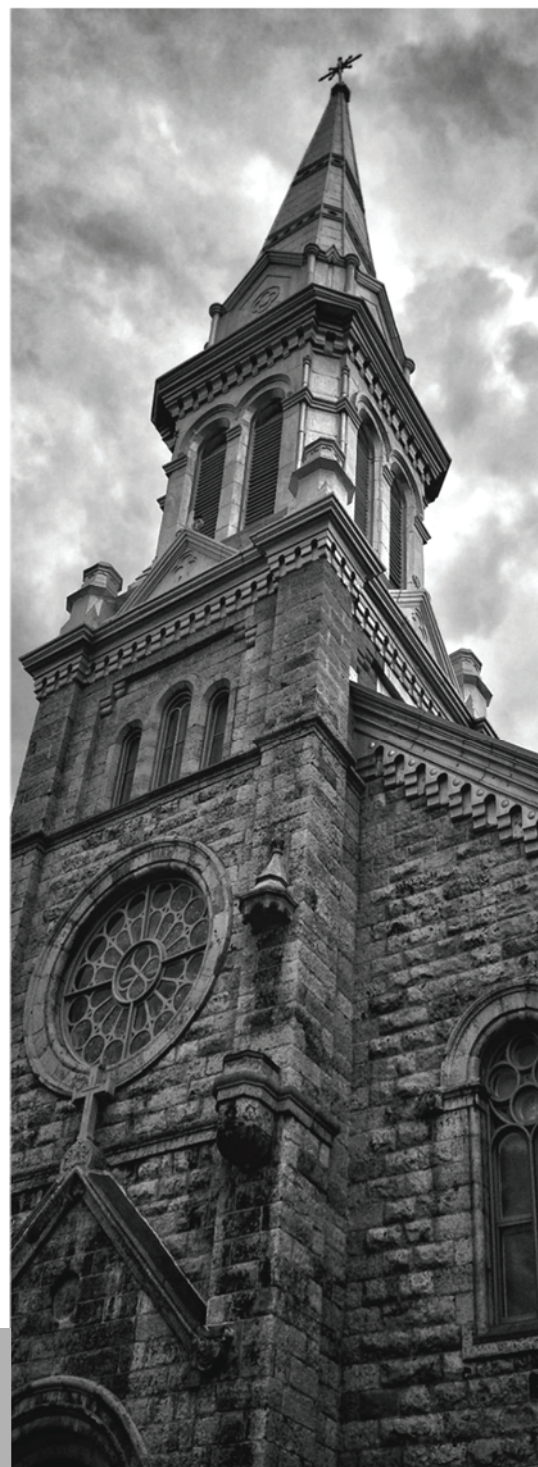

SHOE COLLECTION FOR CENTRE 105

One of the support workers at Centre 105 had a great idea - to start collecting used shoes! They are often asked for shoes, as many individuals who visit our program have shoes that are no longer in good condition. Shoes that are too small or that have rips can lead to many problems, especially for those who walk long distances.

Every Friday, Centre 105 hosts a visit from the Recovery Care Mobile Clinic. They often hear from Mel, the nurse who attends, that one of the top issues she sees is foot and leg problems.

If you have any used shoes that are still in good condition, we will be collecting them over the next few weeks; the boxes are at the entrance of the Church.

LIVING WITH CHRIST MONTHLY MISSALS

Missals for August are available at the Church for purchase; the cost is \$3.25 each, and you can pick one up Tuesday – Friday before or after 7:30 a.m. Mass or at the weekend Masses.

ST. JULIEN'S CHAPEL

THE SANCTUARY LAMP

The living flame of the sanctuary lamp signifies the Eucharistic presence of our Lord Jesus Christ. Sponsorship of the Sanctuary Lamp is available for a week-long period. The stipend is \$20.00 per week, and the intention will be listed in the bulletin.

PRAYING AND WORKING FOR PEACE

On August 6 and 9, 1945, the cities of Hiroshima and Nagasaki were ravaged by atomic bombs. Speaking to victims of this atomic warfare, Saint John Paul II said: "It is with deep emotion that I greet today all those who still carry in their bodies the signs of the destruction that was visited on them on the day of the unforgettable fire. What you endured has also inflicted a wound on the heart of every human being on earth. Your life here today is the most convincing appeal that could be addressed to all people of goodwill against war and for peace.... We are all indebted to you for the living and constant appeal for peace that you are." (Nagasaki, February 26, 1981)
