BECOMING INTENTIONAL DISCIPLES

In recent decades, there has been little or no serious discussion at the parish level about how an individual receiving the Sacraments can prepare his or her heart, soul, and life to do so fruitfully. Yet in many, if not most of our parishes, we have accepted a passive, notional “faith,” a general absence of fruit, and a lack of overt manifestation of grace as normal.

If our pastoral practice is to be life changing, then we must be acutely aware that the Reception of a valid Sacrament and the fruitful reception of Sacramental grace are two different but related issues.

The Church has long distinguished between “objective” redemption and “subjective” redemption.

- **Objective Redemption:** By His life, death, and resurrection, Jesus has already reconciled our race with the Father; this is objective redemption.
- **Subjective Redemption:** is the application of the saving gifts of Christ to individuals, the realization of salvific transformation in each of our lives.

Adults and children past the age of reason are not merely passive subjects to whom salvation “happens”.

Rather, we are active agents who are, in the words of Jesus, called to love God with all our heart, soul, mind and strength. (see Mark 12:30)

“God created us without us: but He did not will to save us without us.” (St. Augustine)

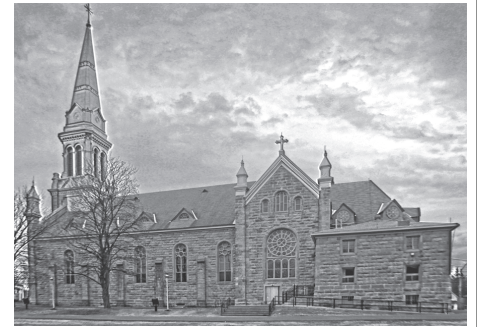
“Positive disposition” means we are prepared to change and we actively seek the grace of God in order to do so.

Passively receiving a Sacrament is not enough. The grace we receive is directly related to the personal faith, spiritual expectancy and hunger with which we approach the Sacrament. Simply going through the motions to please others is not enough for fruitful reception.

“FAITH” has two different meanings in reference to the Sacraments. The *virtus fidei* (infant at Baptism) must become *actus fidei* (explicit personal faith) for a teen/adult to receive a Sacrament fruitfully.

1. **Virtus fidei (the virtue of faith)** – Baptized Christians who were “still without any explicit personal attachment to Jesus Christ” have only the capacity to believe placed within them by Baptism and the presence of the Holy Spirit.” (St. John Paul the Great)
2. **Actus fidei (explicit, personal act of faith)** – the heart of discipleship is faith infused with hope and love
3. **Fides informis (dead faith)** – intellectual assent to the doctrines of the Catholic faith alone, without charity and good works.

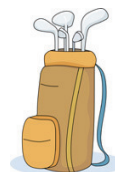
