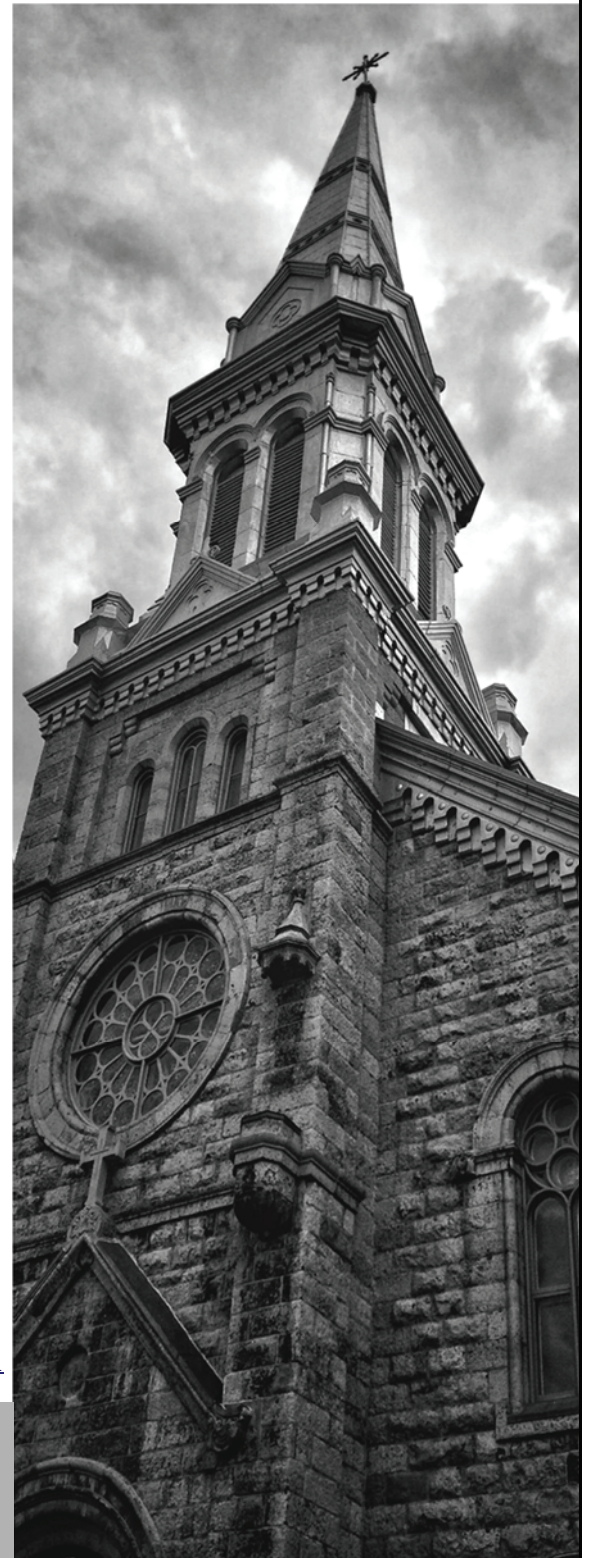

Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."* Acts 1:8

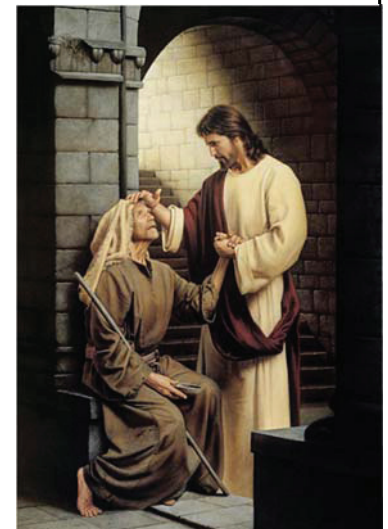
