#### HAPPY BIRTHDAY, CHURCH

Differing from the Jewish celebration of the same name, Pentecost, the 50th and final day of the Easter Season, celebrates the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles in the book of Acts, ushering in the beginning of the Church.

Pentecost is a perfect time for Christians to focus on the role of the Holy Spirit in their individual lives and in their worshipping communities.

On Pentecost the gift of the Holy Spirit was given to the disciples. We too receive the gift of the Holy Spirit at Baptism. The Sacrament of Confirmation completes Baptism and seals us with the gift of the Spirit so that we may be strengthened to go forth and bear witness to Christ, as did the first apostles.


In the New Testament the Spirit is described as descending upon Jesus at His Baptism. But the fullness of the Holy Spirit was meant not only for Jesus, but also for the entire people of God. Jesus promised that the outpouring of the Spirit would be the gift that He would send to His Church. Like all of God's spiritual gifts, we benefit from them to the degree that we are open to the Holy Spirit and His promptings.

In his homily for Pentecost 2015, Pope Francis had the following to say.

The world needs men and women who are not closed in on themselves, but filled with the Holy Spirit. Closing oneself off from the Holy Spirit means not only a lack of freedom; it is a sin. ... However, the world needs the courage, hope, faith and perseverance of Christ's followers. The world needs the fruits, the gifts of the Holy Spirit, as Saint Paul lists them: "love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control" (Gal 5:22). The gift of the Holy Spirit has been bestowed upon the Church and upon each one of us, so that we may live lives of genuine faith and active charity, that we may sow the seeds of reconciliation and peace. Strengthened by the Spirit - Who guides, Who guides us into the truth, Who renews us and the whole earth, and Who gives us His fruits - strengthened in the Spirit and by these many gifts, may we be able to battle uncompromisingly against sin, to battle uncompromisingly against corruption, which continues to spread in the world day after day, by devoting ourselves with patient perseverance to the works of justice and peace.

#### PRAYER OF POPE FRANCIS FOR THE JUBILEE
