GROWING DEEPER IN YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD

Why are so many people not growing deeper in their relationship with God?

The Bible tells us that we should be conscious of ourselves and of our teaching. Paul instructs Timothy, "Practice these things; be committed to them, so that your progress may be evident to all" (1 Tim. 4:15). In other words, it matters how you are growing and how you're leading your people to grow.

I believe that we would see more fruitful discipleship in our churches if we were to start by questioning our own spiritual formation before we question the development of those we lead and disciple. Are we seeking God in prayer, spending time in His Word, and surrounding ourselves with people who will challenge us to grow in our spiritual lives? **Transformational discipleship** involves moving from being in proximity to one another to being in community with one another. And it starts with you and with me.

Based on the results of a study of 2,300 churches sponsored by 15 denominations, we were able to identify eight "attributes of discipleship" that consistently show up in the life of a maturing Christian:

- Bible engagement,
- obeying God and denying self,
- serving God and others,
- sharing Christ,
- exercising faith,
- seeking God,
- building relationships,
- and unashamed transparency.



And our conclusion: God shapes congregations through the shaping of the individual lives of people. And this shaping doesn't just happen randomly. God grows us as we place ourselves in a position of obedience to receive that growth.

An example in our own parish:

Three DISCOVERY Bible study groups are currently in Week 4 of a six week discipleship study - seeking to grow deeper in their relationship with God through Scripture engagement, obeying God, denying self, serving God and others, sharing Christ, exercising faith, building relationships and even entering into a degree of unashamed transparency in small groups. Oh - and they've been invited to **give God permission** to have His way in their lives and in our parish community. It is anticipated that in the new year, some of these parishioners will continue to the next level and more of these groups will be launched with additional parishioners.
