That rustle in the autumn breeze,

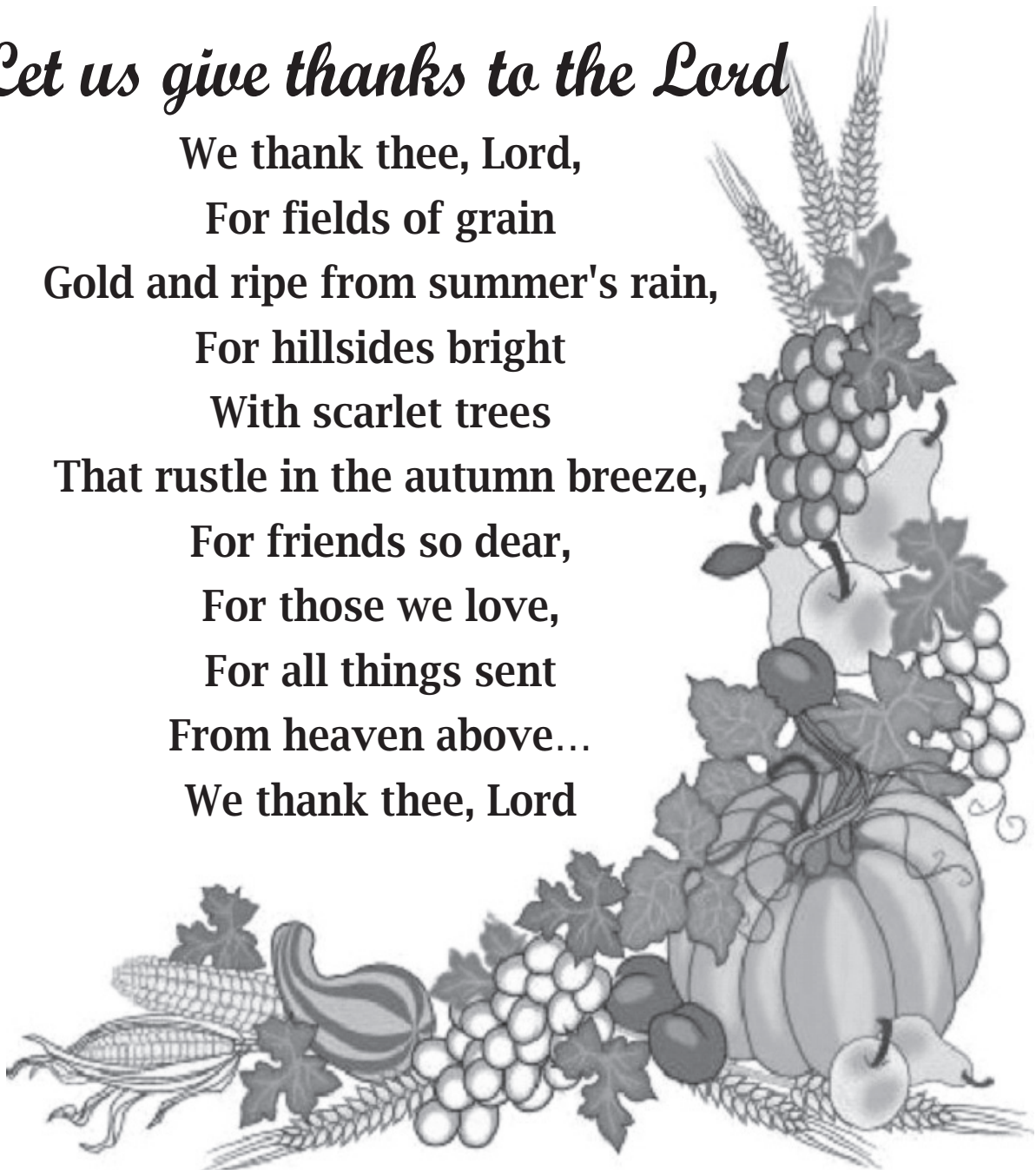

## EXTRAORDINARY MISSIONARY MONTH
