How many of us cling to things that interfere with getting closer to God? Sins of envy, gluttony, greed or avarice, lust, pride, sloth or wrath are often confused with what we need and want and we sometimes try to justify hanging onto them. Jesus identifies faith as the key that can help us find the way when we are blinded by confusion over what is important. Faith will save us.



EMBS PENSION PLAN

The priests' pension plan annual collection will take place Sunday November 4. Last year's collection generated \$66,581. We are very appreciative of your concern for our welfare. You may recall that when we began seeking your help, the monthly pension was at \$750. The number of retired priests outnumber the active priests by a ratio of almost 2 to 1. In July of 2014, we were able to raise the pension to \$800 per month. Our target is to reach \$1,100 and we had hoped to implement another adjustment to \$875 per month effective July 1 of 2016. However, because of continued low interest rates plus a change in the mortality experience (people are living longer therefore more money is required to pay the monthly pension), we have had to postpone increasing the monthly pension. There is a current deficit that must first be eliminated before we can consider a change and this will likely take a few years. We thank you for your consideration and generosity.
