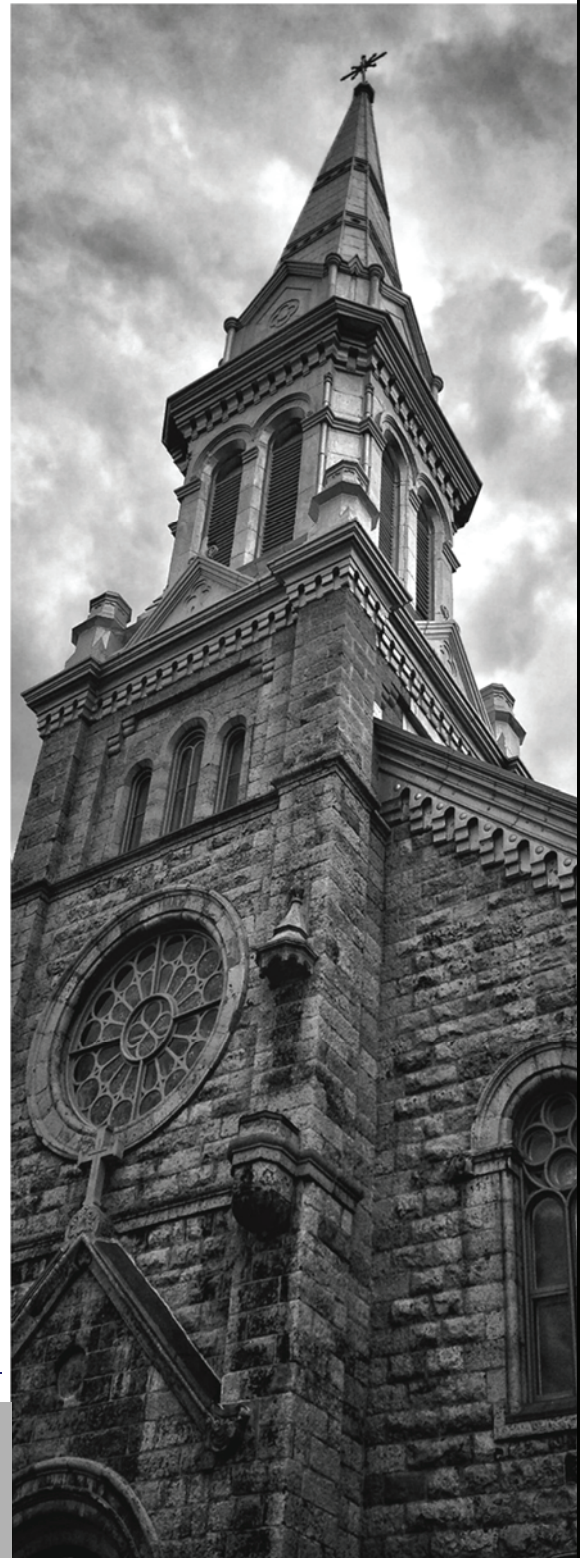

JOY OF THE LORD PRAYER MEETINGS

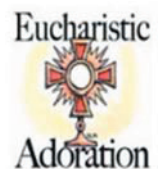

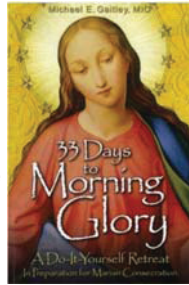
ECUMENICAL VICTORIAN TEA
