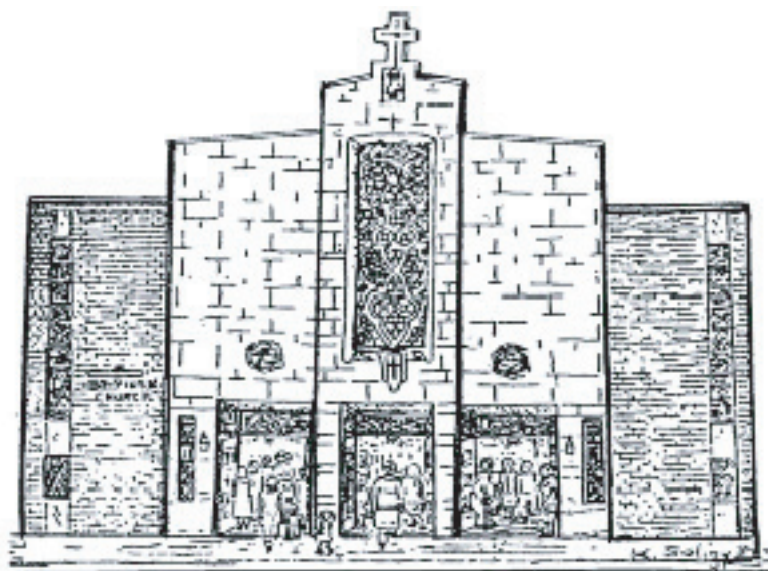

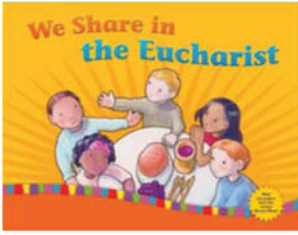

## We Share in the Eucharist



That's the title of the book the children who are preparing for First Communion are using. Even though the workbook is designed with 7-year-old's in mind, it touches the most important aspects of what we believe when we gather to celebrate the Eucharist.

The first chapter is called, "We Walk with Jesus." The children are introduced to the idea that just as Jesus called us to follow him when we were baptized, Jesus invites us to the Table of the Lord with the whole parish community. When we go to Mass we meet the risen Jesus in a special way. Jesus gives himself to us.

The English word "Mass" comes from the Latin word 'missa,' which means to be "sent." This Latin word has been used since the 6th or 7th century to describe the celebration of the Eucharist. The word was used during the conclusion of the celebration, when the priest or deacon said in Latin, "Ite, missa est" or literally, "Go. It has been sent."



We are meant to take the final words of Mass not as a conclusion but as a starting point for a lifelong journey of witness to the Gospel – "Go, in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life!"

Please keep the children preparing to celebrate Eucharist, fully, for the first time, and their families in your prayers.
