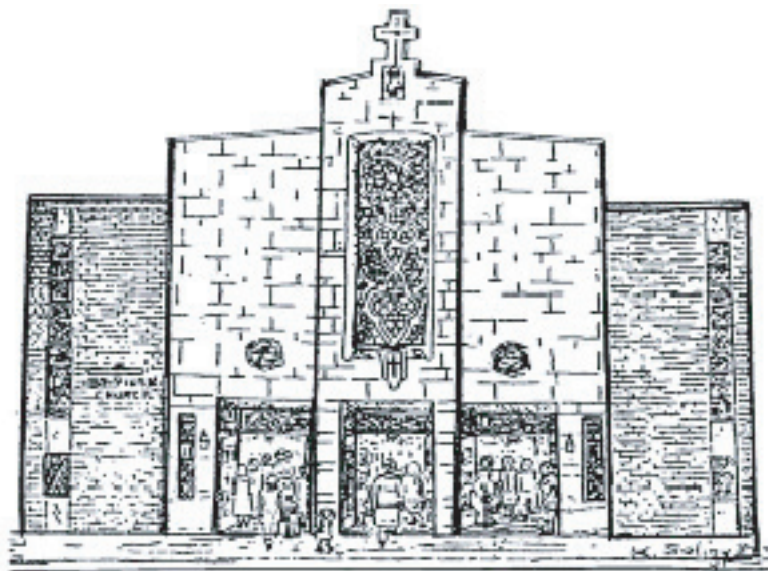

We are invited to be guided by God's Word just as airline pilots trust proven technology and procedures to guide them to a safe landing.

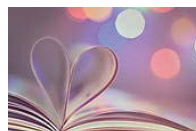

Monthly Building Fund Collection



Once a month, the parish takes up a building fund collection. 100% of that collection goes toward the maintenance of the structure we call St. Pius X Church. Opened in 1954, the church building has served the community well but like any 65-year-old needs maintenance and repair.

Necessary upgrades to our fire safety system cost us in January:

Emergency lighting repair:	\$ 436
Fire alarm repair:	\$ 470
Heat detector wiring issue:	<u>\$1760</u>
Total:	\$2566



Each dollar of the Building Fund goes toward maintenance and repair. Of the general Offertory Collection, 85% goes to pay salaries of parish employees, office supplies and everything else connected to the operation of the parish. 15% of the general Offertory Collection is remitted to the Archdiocese of Toronto to cover the cost of Archdiocesan offices and employees.

In 2018, parishioners donated a total of \$17,449.75 or an average of \$1,454.16 per month. Thanks to all for your generosity.
