

Welcome Bishop Robert Kasun to St. Pius X!

Today we welcome Bishop Robert Kasun, who is visiting St. Pius X for the first time.

Bishop Kasun was born and raised in Cudworth, Saskatchewan. Following ordination to the priesthood with the Basilian Fathers in 1978, he taught in many Basilian schools including Merriville, Indiana, Sudbury, Ontario and his longest assignment at St. Michael's College School here in Toronto.

He also served as Vocations Director for the Basilian Fathers based in Rochester, New York, and as a teacher at St. Francis High School in Calgary. He served on the General Council of the Basilian Fathers from 1989 to 1997 as Regional Representative for Western Canada, and as Vice-President of the Canadian Religious Conference Western Division.

Bishop Kasun was appointed as an auxiliary bishop of the Archdiocese of Toronto on June 17, 2016 and oversees the care and the pastoral needs of the Central Pastoral Region.

We are so happy that he is here to celebrate with us today. Bishop will be here again in May to celebrate the sacrament of Confirmation with our young people who have been preparing since September. We look forward to welcoming him back again!

Taizé Prayer Service

Friday, January 26 @ 7:30pm

In the 1940's a group of men created a prayer community in the small village of Taizé, in France. Since that time, it has become a pilgrimage spot for people from all over the world to pray together with this community, encounter God and for the reconciliation of Christians of all faiths.



Taizé prayer is flexible and has no real beginning or end. Songs are repeated over and over again to help us enter into the contemplation of the presence of God. The main purpose of Taizé music is to bring about a complete participation of all who are present; it is a way of saying what words cannot say and of expressing a spiritual image that swells from the depths of the human heart. Therefore, throughout the service we can expect periods of silence to allow for deeper reflection.
