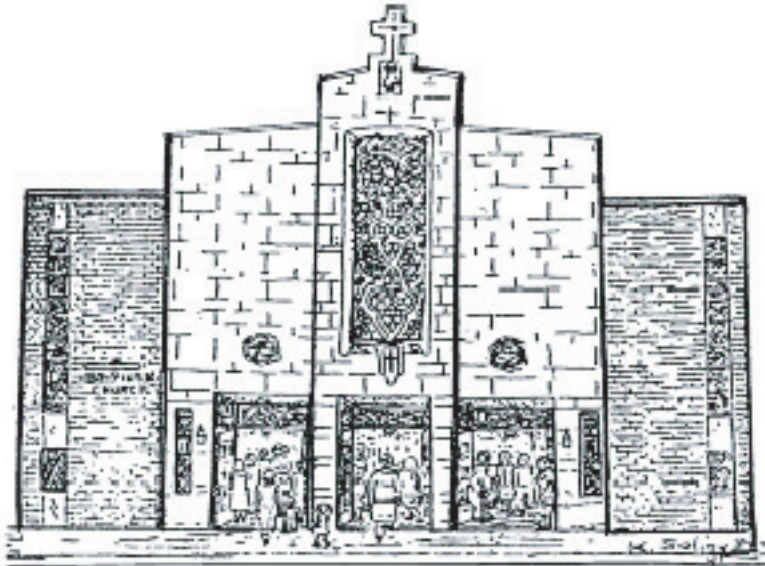

Last weekend, a member of St. Pius X finance council spoke about our financial checkup at the end of each Mass. The report was positive.



The financial report tells us that in terms of the goals we set as a Catholic community of faith, to help others (ShareLife, missions and other special collections), support the infrastructure of the church (building, staff and supplies), we are doing well.

This is what some people call – Stewardship of **Resources**. There are two other components of stewardship that are equally as important – **Time** and **Talent**.

In a vibrant parish, members of the community of faith are conscious of their stewardship. An annual checkup of how we have used our **Time** and **Talent** tells us how we are doing as we strive to be the Body of Christ.



For instance, look at the parishioners who recently stepped forward to offer their **time** and **talent** as lectors to proclaim the Word of God.

### An Attitude of Gratitude

Our community of faith is grateful to those who volunteered their time and talent this year (September to May) to help facilitate sacramental preparation and children's liturgy.

As pastor, I often get feedback from parents who say how much their kids enjoy going to children's liturgy. It helps to promote faith conversations within the family.

Believe it or not most of the children's sacramental preparation happens at home. Each girl or boy preparing for First Reconciliation and First Communion has a workbook that requires a joint effort between parent and child.

The same is also true for the Confirmation process. Youth preparing for Confirmation must dialogue with their parents.

Particularly, I would like to thank organizers Janet Kotyk (Reconciliation, Eucharist) and Virginia Novak (Confirmation).
