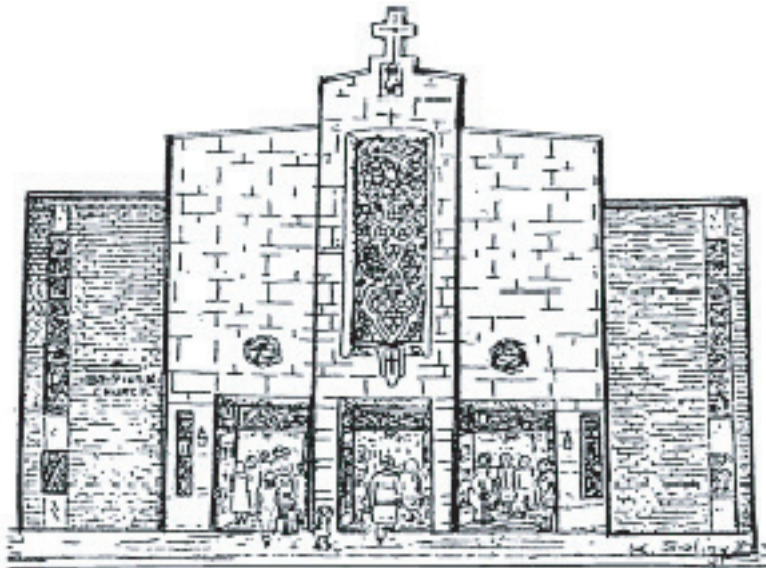

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY



Faith provides us with a window into the beyond. It gives us access to another world—the world of the eternal, the world of God. But our preoccupation with the here-and-now can deprive us of ‘the beyond’, can draw a curtain over the window. However, though we may bury our transcendent longings, we can’t extinguish them.

There is a desire to possess something beyond the world we know, beyond ourselves, even beyond our power of imagining. This is where our faith comes in.

The First Nations people have a prayer:
“O Great Spirit, whose voice I hear in the winds, and whose breath gives life to the world, hear me. I come to you as one of your many children. I am small and weak; I need your strength and your wisdom. Make my eyes ever behold the red and purple sunset. Make my hands respect the things you have made, and my ears sharp to hear your voice. Make me wise so that I may know the things you have taught your children, the lessons you have hidden in every leaf and rock. Make me strong, so that I may not be superior to other people, but able to fight my greatest enemy, which is myself. Make me ever ready to come to you with open eyes, so that when life fades as the fading sunset, my spirit may come to you without shame.”



God is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. In God the Father we have a Father who cares deeply about us. In Jesus we have a brother who dies for us, and who has promised to remain with us always. And in the Holy Spirit, we have a Comforter, who guides us to the kingdom of eternity.
