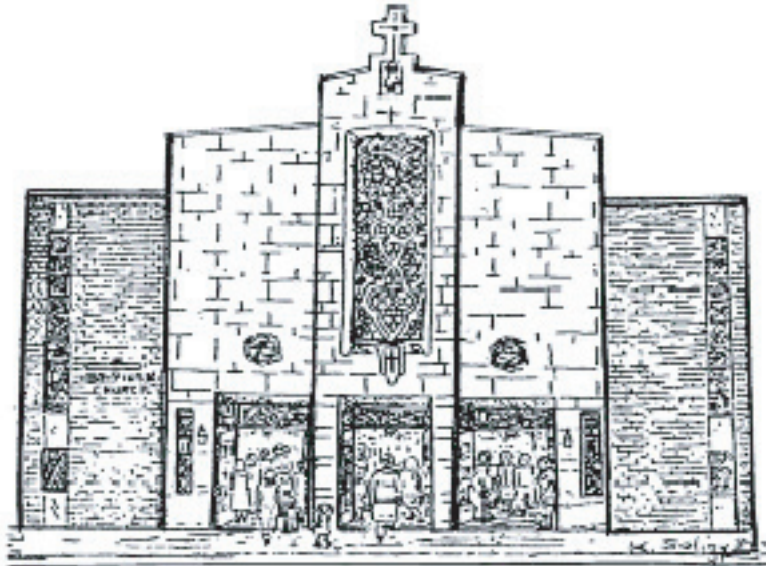

Try This Ancient Form of Prayer

Lectio Divina

"Lectio Divina", a Latin term, means "divine reading" and describes a way of reading the Scriptures whereby we gradually let go of our own agenda and open ourselves to what God wants to say to us. In the 12th century, a Carthusian monk called Guigo, described the stages which he saw as essential to the practice of Lectio Divina. There are various ways of practicing Lectio Divina either individually or in groups but Guigo's description remains fundamental.

There are **four** steps:

1. Reading
2. Reflection
3. Response
4. Rest

This is a great way to prepare for the coming weekend. Take the readings for the Tenth Sunday of Ordinary Time, at the bottom of this page and use them for your 'Lectio'.

On the other hand, using all of the readings for next Sunday may be too much. Take the most important reading – the gospel for your Lectio Divina.

When you come to Mass next weekend, you will be amazed at how the readings speak to you. And yet, when you hear the scripture readings proclaimed in church next weekend, you will also 'hear' it in a fresh way. God speaks to us in the present moment.
