Please continue to pray for good weather and the safety of our construction workers.

MB - Supervision, safety, tarping narthex and parish hall slab on grade, site clean. Percon-Parking lot grading complete, underground storm complete. Waiting on Region of Peel's approval for directional boring to bring water service into church's property. BCON -All foundations 100% complete. Bramalea - Parish hall steel delivered and 50% installed. Installation is behind and needs to get back on track. Narthex steel to be delivered Dec 12th. Granite Prestressed Concrete-Schedules Dec 19-20th to set remaining precast and grout floor. Swift Mechanical Plumbing- Parish hall underground plumbing 100% complete and backfilled. Underground washroom plumbing in Narthex 100% complete. Hook up temporary sump pump from pits to outside. Swift Mechanical HVAC-Underground duct rough in complete serving front vestibule. Antech - Parking lot light rough in 90%. Pouring light pole bases this week. Dominion Waterproofing - Dampproofing / waterproofing 100% complete. Timber Systems-Main Structure complete. Connection plates being installed. Tongue and groove deck to start Dec 12th. Duron - Basement floor complete. Narthex and parish hall slab on grade complete

Some families may want to sponsor the whole pew, while others may just want to sponsor one or several sections.
