FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Deacon Michael Ho was born and raised in Hong Kong, where he married his wife Isabella and where they had two children, Teresa and John Paul. They all attended Catholic schools and Michael's faith has been fostered by the Marist Brothers since his youth. His family emigrated to Canada in 1988. Michael and Isabella have now been married for 35 years and both of their children are now married as well.

Michael's professional background was in finance and banking. He entered the teaching profession in 1998, and at the present time he is working as an ESL instructor for the York Catholic District School Board.

After attending the archdiocesan 'Called by Name' event in 1999, Michael responded to the call to the Deaconate and was accepted to the Formation Program at St. Augustine's Seminary the following year. He was ordained a Permanent Deacon in 2004 for the Archdiocese of Toronto and then carried out his liturgical ministry at Chinese Martyrs Parish in Markham for 6 years.

Deacon Ho also serves as the Associate Chaplain of the Apostleship of the Sea. Working together with the Anglican ministers, he provides ecumenical service for sailors at the Port of Toronto. He completed the Houston Maritime Chaplains' Training Program in 2005. He is currently an accredited Instructor for the Ship Welfare Visitor Course of International Committee on Seafarers' Welfare, U.K.

Week of Christian Unity

January 18-25

The 2011 prayers for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity have been prepared by Christians in Jerusalem, who chose as a theme Acts 2:42, 'They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.' This theme is a call back to the origins of the first church in Jerusalem; it is a call for inspiration and renewal, a return to the essentials of the faith; it is a call to remember the time when the church was still one. Within this theme four elements are presented which were marks of the early Christian community, and which are essential to the life of the Christian Community wherever it exists. Firstly, the Word was passed on by the apostles. Secondly, fellowship (koinonia) was an important mark of the early believers whenever they met together. A third mark of the early Church was the celebration of the Eucharist (the 'breaking of the bread'), remembering the New Covenant which Jesus has enacted in his suffering, death and resurrection. The fourth aspect is the offering of constant prayer. These four elements are the pillars of the life of the church, and of its unity. The Christian Community in the Holy Land wishes to give prominence to these basic essentials as it raises its prayers to God for the unity and vitality of the church throughout the world. The Christians of Jerusalem invite their sisters and brothers around the world to join them in prayer as they struggle for justice, peace and prosperity for all people of the land.

When we read the Bible together in our diversity of language and context, Revealing One who makes us one, make our unity visible and bring healing to the world.
