World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life

On Wednesday, February 2, 2011, the Church celebrates the World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life. The purpose of this day is "to help the entire Church to esteem ever more greatly the witness of those persons who have chosen to follow Christ by means of the practice of evangelical counsels" as well as "to be a suitable occasion for consecrated persons to renew their commitment and rekindle the fervor which should inspire their offering of themselves to the Lord." (The Servant of God, John Paul II, 1997 message). Our present Holy Father, Benedict XVI, also tells us that "consecrated people are called in a special way to be witnesses of the mercy of the Lord in which human beings find their salvation. Consecrated people are a vivid experience of God's forgiveness, because they know that they are people saved, that they are great when they see themselves as small and feel renewed and enveloped by the holiness if God when they recognize their sins. For this reason, for contemporary men and women too, consecrated life remains a privileged school of "compunction of heart", of the humble recognition of one's poverty but it likewise remains a school of trust in God's mercy, in his love that never abandons us. Actually the closer we become to God, the closer we are to him, the more helpful we are to others. Consecrated people experience God's grace, mercy and forgiveness not only for themselves but also for their brothers and sisters since they are called to carry in their hearts and prayers the anxieties and expectations of human beings, especially those who are far from God." (Message, 2010)

In the Archdiocese of Toronto we are blessed to have living and serving among us more than 1,100 religious men and women, over 100 different religious congregations. In our parish community, we have two sisters on staff, Sister Cristina and Sister Necy, and one parishioner, Sister Ruth of the Sisters of St. Joseph. This World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life is a wonderful opportunity for us to thank God for the gifts of these religious sisters, brothers and priests and to pray for God's blessing upon them in their efforts to faithfully live the evangelical counsels of poverty, chastity, and obedience.

On Sunday, January 30, 2011 at St. Paul's Basilica in downtown Toronto, 3 PM, there will be a special Mass in celebration of the vocation and witness of these special men and women religious who are such a vital and important part of the life and ministry of the Church in our Archdiocese. All are invited to attend.

Feast of the Presentation of the Lord February 2, 2011

The Feast of the Presentation, often called Candlemas, commemorates the purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the presentation of Christ in the temple, which took place 40 days after his birth as Jewish law required.

The Feast is also called Candlemas. The name Candlemas comes from the activities associated with the feast. Hence, on Wednesday, we will be blessing candles.
