FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

This Sunday, we are given an opportunity to remember and celebrate the baptism of the Lord by John in the river Jordan and our own baptism into Christ. As we reflect on the significance of this sacrament, it may be helpful to remind ourselves what the sacrament is not.

First and foremost, baptism is not a final goal, but the beginning of a lifelong process of becoming one with Christ, in Christ, and for Christ. All too often we hear people say that church is only when they are hatched, matched, and dispatched (to correspond to three occasions during their lifetime when they go to church - at baptism, marriage, and funeral). It is good to remind ourselves that baptism is a sacrament of initiation which plots the course and sets the tenor for what must follow; a life lived in consonance with, and as a consequence of that initial dedication.

Secondly, baptism cannot be an empty ritual. Many of you have seen the movie "The Godfather" - in the movie, during the baptism of one of the Corleone children, as the ceremony was unfolding, scenes of murder, violence and mayhem were also interjected by the Director of the movie to indicate that each profession of faith was hollow and each renunciation of evil was a lie. In effect, the family's participation in the baptism was mere sham rather than a defining moment intended to give direction and meaning to the faith-life of the child for which they were responsible.

In the Scriptural readings of today's feast, we are presented with the image of the Isaian servant, whose job description of saving his contemporaries is outlined. As Christians, we bring to the Hebrew prophecy the understanding that the personal qualities and job description of the servant were fully realized in the saving work and suffering death of Jesus. As we read the text in this manner, we, who have been baptized into Christ, also realize that Jesus' job description of selfless suffering and saving service is the pattern for our lives. And so, just as the Isaian servant was empowered, and just as Jesus was empowered for service by the Spirit of God, God's Spirit also empowers those who are baptized into Christ to accomplish the impossible task of bringing justice into the world.

What is biblical justice? The biblical concept of justice can be described as "fidelity to the demands of a relationship." In other words, it is the promotion of a network of equitable, trusting, life-giving relationships whereby every member of the human community, from the least to the greatest is united with others by familial bonds. At the heart of this network is the all-important relationships with God, from which all other relationships must necessarily derive.

This type of justice cannot be achieved by political machinations nor by military might, but with gentleness and caution, respect for persons who are weak, fragile, and in jeopardy.

Aside from the empowerment that the Spirit of God gives, there is also an additional promise given to those who continue the mission of Jesus in this world: "I have grasped you by the hand". Held tightly by God's grace and presence, we become capable of reaching out, to grasp, to hold, and to fill every hand that is extended to us in need.
