Dominion Waterproofing-100 % complete. Bramalea - Parish hall -95% complete. Outstanding hall steel to be installed: 3 trimmers angles, roof top unit/ ladder hatch steel reinforcing, 8 galvanized reinforcing pieces on galvanized high roof, sliding partition steel with extension posts, 1 rolled galvanized arch over entrance way and galvanized roof screens. Narthex- 80% complete. Outstanding Narthex steel to be installed: Roof top unit steel reinforcing, 3 rolled galvanized arches and some vestibule HSS. Basement 100% complete. Office -10% complete and ongoing. Nave-Clererstory tower delivered. Granite Prestressed Concrete-100% Complete.

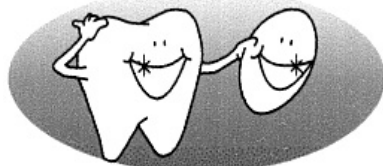
